



BEARFACTS 1991 – 2001

Russell , Kansas [20167]

Russell is one of 105 counties in Kansas. It is not part of a Metropolitan Area. Its 2001 population of 7,151 ranked 54th in the state.

PER CAPITA PERSONAL INCOME

In 2001 Russell had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$22,616. This PCPI ranked 66th in the state and was 79 percent of the state average, \$28,713, and 74 percent of the national average, \$30,582. The 2001 PCPI reflected a decrease of 3.9 percent from 2000. The 2000-2001 state change was 3.7 percent and the national change was 2.5 percent. In 1991 the PCPI of Russell was \$16,868 and ranked 39th in the state. The 1991-2001 average annual growth rate of PCPI was 3.0 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 4.4 percent and for the nation was 4.4 percent.

TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME

In 2001 Russell had a total personal income (TPI) of \$161,725*. This TPI ranked 57th in the state and accounted for 0.2 percent of the state total. In 1991 the TPI of Russell was \$131,013* and ranked 49th in the state. The 2001 TPI reflected a decrease of 6.5 percent from 2000. The 2000-2001 state change was 4.0 percent and the national change was 3.5 percent. The 1991-2001 average annual growth rate of TPI was 2.1 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 5.2 percent and for the nation was 5.6 percent.

COMPONENTS OF TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME

Total personal income includes net earnings by place of residence; dividends, interest, and rent; and personal current transfer receipts received by the residents of Russell. In 2001 net earnings accounted for 41.5 percent of TPI (compared with 46.9 in 1991); dividends, interest, and rent were 30.7 percent (compared with 31.3 in 1991); and personal current transfer receipts were 27.8 percent (compared with 21.8 in 1991). From 2000 to 2001 net earnings decreased 17.6 percent; dividends, interest, and rent increased 1.5 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased 5.6 percent. From 1991 to 2001 net earnings increased on average 0.9 percent each year; dividends, interest, and rent increased on average 1.9 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased on average 4.6 percent.

EARNINGS BY PLACE OF WORK

Earnings of persons employed in Russell decreased from \$92,812* in 2000 to \$76,870* in 2001, a decrease of 17.2 percent. The 2000-2001 state change was 4.4 percent and the national change was 3.1 percent. The average annual growth rate from the 1991 estimate of \$71,625* to the 2001 estimate was 0.7 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 5.6 percent and for the nation was 5.8 percent.
