



## **BEARFACTS 1991 – 2001**

### **Toole , Montana [30101]**

Toole is one of 56 counties in Montana. It is not part of a Metropolitan Area. Its 2001 population of 5,277 ranked 34th in the state.

#### **PER CAPITA PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2001 Toole had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$21,441. This PCPI ranked 33rd in the state and was 87 percent of the state average, \$24,683, and 70 percent of the national average, \$30,582. The 2001 PCPI reflected an increase of 0.6 percent from 2000. The 2000-2001 state change was 7.6 percent and the national change was 2.5 percent. In 1991 the PCPI of Toole was \$19,095 and ranked 4th in the state. The 1991-2001 average annual growth rate of PCPI was 1.2 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 4.2 percent and for the nation was 4.4 percent.

#### **TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2001 Toole had a total personal income (TPI) of \$113,145\*. This TPI ranked 34th in the state and accounted for 0.5 percent of the state total. In 1991 the TPI of Toole was \$95,972\* and ranked 31st in the state. The 2001 TPI reflected an increase of 0.8 percent from 2000. The 2000-2001 state change was 7.9 percent and the national change was 3.5 percent. The 1991-2001 average annual growth rate of TPI was 1.7 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 5.4 percent and for the nation was 5.6 percent.

#### **COMPONENTS OF TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

Total personal income includes net earnings by place of residence; dividends, interest, and rent; and personal current transfer receipts received by the residents of Toole. In 2001 net earnings accounted for 57.3 percent of TPI (compared with 63.6 in 1991); dividends, interest, and rent were 25.2 percent (compared with 22.9 in 1991); and personal current transfer receipts were 17.6 percent (compared with 13.6 in 1991). From 2000 to 2001 net earnings decreased 3.4 percent; dividends, interest, and rent increased 9.6 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased 3.9 percent. From 1991 to 2001 net earnings increased on average 0.6 percent each year; dividends, interest, and rent increased on average 2.7 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased on average 4.3 percent.

#### **EARNINGS BY PLACE OF WORK**

Earnings of persons employed in Toole decreased from \$82,560\* in 2000 to \$81,167\* in 2001, a decrease of 1.7 percent. The 2000-2001 state change was 8.8 percent and the national change was 3.1 percent. The average annual growth rate from the 1991 estimate of \$71,137\* to the 2001 estimate was 1.3 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 5.4 percent and for the nation was 5.8 percent.

*\*Note: All income estimates with the exception of PCPI are in thousands of dollars, not adjusted for inflation.*
