



## **BEARFACTS 1991 – 2001**

### **Arthur , Nebraska [31005]**

Arthur is one of 93 counties in Nebraska. It is not part of a Metropolitan Area. Its 2001 population of 409 ranked 93rd in the state.

#### **PER CAPITA PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2001 Arthur had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$10,350. This PCPI ranked 91st in the state and was 36 percent of the state average, \$28,703, and 34 percent of the national average, \$30,582. The 2001 PCPI reflected an increase of 15.8 percent from 2000. The 2000-2001 state change was 3.9 percent and the national change was 2.5 percent. In 1991 the PCPI of Arthur was \$11,991 and ranked 89th in the state. The 1991-2001 average annual growth rate of PCPI was - 1.5 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 4.5 percent and for the nation was 4.4 percent.

#### **TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2001 Arthur had a total personal income (TPI) of \$4,233\*. This TPI ranked 93rd in the state and accounted for 0.0 percent of the state total. In 1991 the TPI of Arthur was \$5,336\* and ranked 92nd in the state. The 2001 TPI reflected an increase of 7.1 percent from 2000. The 2000-2001 state change was 4.2 percent and the national change was 3.5 percent. The 1991-2001 average annual growth rate of TPI was - 2.3 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 5.2 percent and for the nation was 5.6 percent.

#### **COMPONENTS OF TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

Total personal income includes net earnings by place of residence; dividends, interest, and rent; and personal current transfer receipts received by the residents of Arthur. From 2000 to 2001 dividends, interest, and rent increased 8.5 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased 14.9 percent. From 1991 to 2001 net earnings cannot be calculated; dividends, interest, and rent increased on average 5.6 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased on average 7.4 percent.

#### **EARNINGS BY PLACE OF WORK**

Earnings of persons employed in Arthur decreased from \$- 1,477\* in 2000 to \$- 1,801\* in 2001. The 2000-2001 state change was 4.3 percent and the national change was 3.1 percent. The average annual growth rate from the 1991 estimate of \$2,376\* to the 2001 estimate cannot be calculated. The average annual growth rate for the state was 5.2 percent and for the nation was 5.8 percent.

*\*Note: All income estimates with the exception of PCPI are in thousands of dollars, not adjusted for inflation.*

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
