



## **BEARFACTS 1991 – 2001**

### **Sioux City (MSA) [43580]**

Sioux City is one of 363 Metropolitan Statistical Areas (MSAs) in the nation. Its 2001 population of 142,470 ranked 260th in the nation.

#### **PER CAPITA PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2001 Sioux City had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$26,425. This PCPI ranked 180th in the United States and was 86 percent of the national average, \$30,582. The 2001 PCPI reflected an increase of 1.8 percent from 2000. The 2000-2001 national change was 2.5 percent. In 1991 the PCPI of Sioux City was \$17,365 and ranked 191st in the United States. The 1991-2001 average annual growth rate of PCPI was 4.3 percent. The average annual growth rate for the nation was 4.4 percent.

#### **TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2001 Sioux City had a total personal income (TPI) of \$3,764,749\*. This TPI ranked 243rd in the United States. In 1991 the TPI of Sioux City was \$2,311,509\* and ranked 241st in the United States. The 2001 TPI reflected an increase of 1.4 percent from 2000. The 2000-2001 national change was 3.5 percent. The 1991-2001 average annual growth rate of TPI was 5.0 percent. The average annual growth rate for the nation was 5.6 percent.

#### **COMPONENTS OF TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

Total personal income includes net earnings by place of residence; dividends, interest, and rent; and personal current transfer receipts received by the residents of Sioux City. In 2001 net earnings accounted for 66.9 percent of TPI (compared with 64.9 in 1991); dividends, interest, and rent were 18.8 percent (compared with 20.0 in 1991); and personal current transfer receipts were 14.4 percent (compared with 15.2 in 1991). From 2000 to 2001 net earnings decreased 0.6 percent; dividends, interest, and rent increased 4.9 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased 6.7 percent. From 1991 to 2001 net earnings increased on average 5.3 percent each year; dividends, interest, and rent increased on average 4.4 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased on average 4.4 percent.

#### **EARNINGS BY PLACE OF WORK**

Earnings of persons employed in Sioux City decreased from \$3,019,477\* in 2000 to \$3,011,613\* in 2001, a decrease of 0.3 percent. The 2000-2001 national change was 3.1 percent. The average annual growth rate from the 1991 estimate of \$1,755,355\* to the 2001 estimate was 5.5 percent. The average annual growth rate for the nation was 5.8 percent.
