



## **BEARFACTS 1991 – 2001**

### **Hughes , South Dakota [46065]**

Hughes is one of 66 counties in South Dakota. It is part of the Pierre, SD Micropolitan SA. Its 2001 population of 16,386 ranked 12th in the state.

#### **PER CAPITA PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2001 Hughes had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$28,628. This PCPI ranked 10th in the state and was 106 percent of the state average, \$26,927, and 94 percent of the national average, \$30,582. The 2001 PCPI reflected an increase of 7.0 percent from 2000. The 2000-2001 state change was 4.7 percent and the national change was 2.5 percent. In 1991 the PCPI of Hughes was \$18,168 and ranked 10th in the state. The 1991-2001 average annual growth rate of PCPI was 4.7 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 4.8 percent and for the nation was 4.4 percent.

#### **TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2001 Hughes had a total personal income (TPI) of \$469,092\*. This TPI ranked 12th in the state and accounted for 2.3 percent of the state total. In 1991 the TPI of Hughes was \$272,253\* and ranked 12th in the state. The 2001 TPI reflected an increase of 6.3 percent from 2000. The 2000-2001 state change was 5.1 percent and the national change was 3.5 percent. The 1991-2001 average annual growth rate of TPI was 5.6 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 5.6 percent and for the nation was 5.6 percent.

#### **COMPONENTS OF TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

Total personal income includes net earnings by place of residence; dividends, interest, and rent; and personal current transfer receipts received by the residents of Hughes. In 2001 net earnings accounted for 64.5 percent of TPI (compared with 68.6 in 1991); dividends, interest, and rent were 23.5 percent (compared with 20.2 in 1991); and personal current transfer receipts were 12.0 percent (compared with 11.3 in 1991). From 2000 to 2001 net earnings increased 7.7 percent; dividends, interest, and rent increased 2.5 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased 7.1 percent. From 1991 to 2001 net earnings increased on average 5.0 percent each year; dividends, interest, and rent increased on average 7.2 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased on average 6.2 percent.

#### **EARNINGS BY PLACE OF WORK**

Earnings of persons employed in Hughes increased from \$350,944\* in 2000 to \$372,216\* in 2001, an increase of 6.1 percent. The 2000-2001 state change was 3.4 percent and the national change was 3.1 percent. The average annual growth rate from the 1991 estimate of \$221,249\* to the 2001 estimate was 5.3 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 5.6 percent and for the nation was 5.8 percent.
