



## **BEARFACTS 1991 – 2001 Crockett , Tennessee [47033]**

Crockett is one of 95 counties in Tennessee. It is not part of a Metropolitan Area. Its 2001 population of 14,532 ranked 77th in the state.

### **PER CAPITA PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2001 Crockett had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$21,729. This PCPI ranked 46th in the state and was 81 percent of the state average, \$26,839, and 71 percent of the national average, \$30,582. The 2001 PCPI reflected a decrease of 4.2 percent from 2000. The 2000-2001 state change was 2.8 percent and the national change was 2.5 percent. In 1991 the PCPI of Crockett was \$15,273 and ranked 30th in the state. The 1991-2001 average annual growth rate of PCPI was 3.6 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 4.5 percent and for the nation was 4.4 percent.

### **TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2001 Crockett had a total personal income (TPI) of \$315,760\*. This TPI ranked 75th in the state and accounted for 0.2 percent of the state total. In 1991 the TPI of Crockett was \$206,369\* and ranked 70th in the state. The 2001 TPI reflected a decrease of 4.3 percent from 2000. The 2000-2001 state change was 3.8 percent and the national change was 3.5 percent. The 1991-2001 average annual growth rate of TPI was 4.3 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 6.0 percent and for the nation was 5.6 percent.

### **COMPONENTS OF TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

Total personal income includes net earnings by place of residence; dividends, interest, and rent; and personal current transfer receipts received by the residents of Crockett. In 2001 net earnings accounted for 56.4 percent of TPI (compared with 63.7 in 1991); dividends, interest, and rent were 19.3 percent (compared with 15.7 in 1991); and personal current transfer receipts were 24.3 percent (compared with 20.5 in 1991). From 2000 to 2001 net earnings decreased 11.2 percent; dividends, interest, and rent increased 4.6 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased 7.8 percent. From 1991 to 2001 net earnings increased on average 3.1 percent each year; dividends, interest, and rent increased on average 6.5 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased on average 6.1 percent.

### **EARNINGS BY PLACE OF WORK**

Earnings of persons employed in Crockett decreased from \$168,917\* in 2000 to \$152,375\* in 2001, a decrease of 9.8 percent. The 2000-2001 state change was 3.4 percent and the national change was 3.1 percent. The average annual growth rate from the 1991 estimate of \$113,344\* to the 2001 estimate was 3.0 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 6.2 percent and for the nation was 5.8 percent.
