



BEARFACTS 1991 – 2001

Knox , Texas [48275]

Knox is one of 254 counties in Texas. It is not part of a Metropolitan Area. Its 2001 population of 4,025 ranked 210th in the state.

PER CAPITA PERSONAL INCOME

In 2001 Knox had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$20,888. This PCPI ranked 166th in the state and was 72 percent of the state average, \$29,045, and 68 percent of the national average, \$30,582. The 2001 PCPI reflected an increase of 14.8 percent from 2000. The 2000-2001 state change was 2.6 percent and the national change was 2.5 percent. In 1991 the PCPI of Knox was \$13,969 and ranked 164th in the state. The 1991-2001 average annual growth rate of PCPI was 4.1 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 4.9 percent and for the nation was 4.4 percent.

TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME

In 2001 Knox had a total personal income (TPI) of \$84,075*. This TPI ranked 214th in the state and accounted for 0.0 percent of the state total. In 1991 the TPI of Knox was \$66,869* and ranked 204th in the state. The 2001 TPI reflected an increase of 8.9 percent from 2000. The 2000-2001 state change was 4.5 percent and the national change was 3.5 percent. The 1991-2001 average annual growth rate of TPI was 2.3 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 7.1 percent and for the nation was 5.6 percent.

COMPONENTS OF TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME

Total personal income includes net earnings by place of residence; dividends, interest, and rent; and personal current transfer receipts received by the residents of Knox. In 2001 net earnings accounted for 50.7 percent of TPI (compared with 50.9 in 1991); dividends, interest, and rent were 19.2 percent (compared with 24.0 in 1991); and personal current transfer receipts were 30.1 percent (compared with 25.0 in 1991). From 2000 to 2001 net earnings increased 11.8 percent; dividends, interest, and rent increased 3.1 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased 7.8 percent. From 1991 to 2001 net earnings increased on average 2.3 percent each year; dividends, interest, and rent remained unchanged; and personal current transfer receipts increased on average 4.2 percent.

EARNINGS BY PLACE OF WORK

Earnings of persons employed in Knox increased from \$43,117* in 2000 to \$46,863* in 2001, an increase of 8.7 percent. The 2000-2001 state change was 4.6 percent and the national change was 3.1 percent. The average annual growth rate from the 1991 estimate of \$38,571* to the 2001 estimate was 2.0 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 7.5 percent and for the nation was 5.8 percent.
