



## **BEARFACTS 1991 – 2001**

### **Llano , Texas [48299]**

Llano is one of 254 counties in Texas. It is not part of a Metropolitan Area. Its 2001 population of 17,443 ranked 128th in the state.

#### **PER CAPITA PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2001 Llano had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$23,164. This PCPI ranked 104th in the state and was 80 percent of the state average, \$29,045, and 76 percent of the national average, \$30,582. The 2001 PCPI remained unchanged from 2000. The 2000-2001 state change was 2.6 percent and the national change was 2.5 percent. In 1991 the PCPI of Llano was \$16,320 and ranked 72nd in the state. The 1991-2001 average annual growth rate of PCPI was 3.6 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 4.9 percent and for the nation was 4.4 percent.

#### **TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2001 Llano had a total personal income (TPI) of \$404,042\*. This TPI ranked 123rd in the state and accounted for 0.1 percent of the state total. In 1991 the TPI of Llano was \$195,564\* and ranked 134th in the state. The 2001 TPI reflected an increase of 1.9 percent from 2000. The 2000-2001 state change was 4.5 percent and the national change was 3.5 percent. The 1991-2001 average annual growth rate of TPI was 7.5 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 7.1 percent and for the nation was 5.6 percent.

#### **COMPONENTS OF TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

Total personal income includes net earnings by place of residence; dividends, interest, and rent; and personal current transfer receipts received by the residents of Llano. In 2001 net earnings accounted for 49.1 percent of TPI (compared with 35.9 in 1991); dividends, interest, and rent were 27.5 percent (compared with 37.6 in 1991); and personal current transfer receipts were 23.4 percent (compared with 26.5 in 1991). From 2000 to 2001 net earnings increased 1.0 percent; dividends, interest, and rent increased 2.5 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased 3.0 percent. From 1991 to 2001 net earnings increased on average 10.9 percent each year; dividends, interest, and rent increased on average 4.2 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased on average 6.2 percent.

#### **EARNINGS BY PLACE OF WORK**

Earnings of persons employed in Llano decreased from \$150,310\* in 2000 to \$144,808\* in 2001, a decrease of 3.7 percent. The 2000-2001 state change was 4.6 percent and the national change was 3.1 percent. The average annual growth rate from the 1991 estimate of \$71,796\* to the 2001 estimate was 7.3 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 7.5 percent and for the nation was 5.8 percent.
