



## **BEARFACTS 1991 – 2001**

### **San Patricio , Texas [48409]**

San Patricio is one of 254 counties in Texas. It is part of the [Corpus Christi, TX \(MSA\)](#). Its 2001 population of 66,874 ranked 48th in the state.

#### **PER CAPITA PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2001 San Patricio had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$20,326. This PCPI ranked 178th in the state and was 70 percent of the state average, \$29,045, and 66 percent of the national average, \$30,582. The 2001 PCPI reflected an increase of 4.7 percent from 2000. The 2000-2001 state change was 2.6 percent and the national change was 2.5 percent. In 1991 the PCPI of San Patricio was \$13,169 and ranked 194th in the state. The 1991-2001 average annual growth rate of PCPI was 4.4 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 4.9 percent and for the nation was 4.4 percent.

#### **TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2001 San Patricio had a total personal income (TPI) of \$1,359,282\*. This TPI ranked 51st in the state and accounted for 0.2 percent of the state total. In 1991 the TPI of San Patricio was \$777,767\* and ranked 48th in the state. The 2001 TPI reflected an increase of 4.1 percent from 2000. The 2000-2001 state change was 4.5 percent and the national change was 3.5 percent. The 1991-2001 average annual growth rate of TPI was 5.7 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 7.1 percent and for the nation was 5.6 percent.

#### **COMPONENTS OF TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

Total personal income includes net earnings by place of residence; dividends, interest, and rent; and personal current transfer receipts received by the residents of San Patricio. In 2001 net earnings accounted for 66.8 percent of TPI (compared with 66.2 in 1991); dividends, interest, and rent were 13.4 percent (compared with 15.2 in 1991); and personal current transfer receipts were 19.8 percent (compared with 18.6 in 1991). From 2000 to 2001 net earnings increased 2.9 percent; dividends, interest, and rent increased 2.5 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased 9.7 percent. From 1991 to 2001 net earnings increased on average 5.8 percent each year; dividends, interest, and rent increased on average 4.4 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased on average 6.4 percent.

#### **EARNINGS BY PLACE OF WORK**

Earnings of persons employed in San Patricio decreased from \$794,939\* in 2000 to \$781,561\* in 2001, a decrease of 1.7 percent. The 2000-2001 state change was 4.6 percent and the national change was 3.1 percent. The average annual growth rate from the 1991 estimate of \$401,882\* to the 2001 estimate was 6.9 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 7.5 percent and for the nation was 5.8 percent.
