



## **BEARFACTS 1991 – 2001 Winchester (MSA) [49020]**

Winchester is one of 363 Metropolitan Statistical Areas (MSAs) in the nation. Its 2001 population of 105,865 ranked 323rd in the nation.

### **PER CAPITA PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2001 Winchester had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$26,474. This PCPI ranked 177th in the United States and was 87 percent of the national average, \$30,582. The 2001 PCPI reflected an increase of 3.5 percent from 2000. The 2000-2001 national change was 2.5 percent. In 1991 the PCPI of Winchester was \$16,476 and ranked 249th in the United States. The 1991-2001 average annual growth rate of PCPI was 4.9 percent. The average annual growth rate for the nation was 4.4 percent.

### **TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2001 Winchester had a total personal income (TPI) of \$2,802,708\*. This TPI ranked 299th in the United States. In 1991 the TPI of Winchester was \$1,433,097\* and ranked 336th in the United States. The 2001 TPI reflected an increase of 5.8 percent from 2000. The 2000-2001 national change was 3.5 percent. The 1991-2001 average annual growth rate of TPI was 6.9 percent. The average annual growth rate for the nation was 5.6 percent.

### **COMPONENTS OF TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

Total personal income includes net earnings by place of residence; dividends, interest, and rent; and personal current transfer receipts received by the residents of Winchester. In 2001 net earnings accounted for 68.7 percent of TPI (compared with 67.8 in 1991); dividends, interest, and rent were 18.4 percent (compared with 20.4 in 1991); and personal current transfer receipts were 12.9 percent (compared with 11.9 in 1991). From 2000 to 2001 net earnings increased 4.3 percent; dividends, interest, and rent increased 6.5 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased 13.2 percent. From 1991 to 2001 net earnings increased on average 7.1 percent each year; dividends, interest, and rent increased on average 5.8 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased on average 7.9 percent.

### **EARNINGS BY PLACE OF WORK**

Earnings of persons employed in Winchester increased from \$1,958,101\* in 2000 to \$2,047,360\* in 2001, an increase of 4.6 percent. The 2000-2001 national change was 3.1 percent. The average annual growth rate from the 1991 estimate of \$1,073,441\* to the 2001 estimate was 6.7 percent. The average annual growth rate for the nation was 5.8 percent.
