



## **BEARFACTS 1991 – 2001**

### **Harrisburg-Carlisle-Lebanon (BEA-EA) [57070]**

Harrisburg-Carlisle-Lebanon is one of 179 BEA Economic Areas in the nation. Its 2001 population of 2,018,851 ranked 35th in the nation.

#### **PER CAPITA PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2001 Harrisburg-Carlisle-Lebanon had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$27,799. This PCPI ranked 52nd in the United States and was 91 percent of the national average, \$30,582. The 2001 PCPI reflected an increase of 1.4 percent from 2000. The 2000-2001 national change was 2.5 percent. In 1991 the PCPI of Harrisburg-Carlisle-Lebanon was \$19,360 and ranked 31st in the United States. The 1991-2001 average annual growth rate of PCPI was 3.7 percent. The average annual growth rate for the nation was 4.4 percent.

#### **TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2001 Harrisburg-Carlisle-Lebanon had a total personal income (TPI) of \$56,121,233\*. This TPI ranked 34th in the United States. In 1991 the TPI of Harrisburg-Carlisle-Lebanon was \$36,501,257\* and ranked 32nd in the United States. The 2001 TPI reflected an increase of 1.7 percent from 2000. The 2000-2001 national change was 3.5 percent. The 1991-2001 average annual growth rate of TPI was 4.4 percent. The average annual growth rate for the nation was 5.6 percent.

#### **COMPONENTS OF TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

Total personal income includes net earnings by place of residence; dividends, interest, and rent; and personal current transfer receipts received by the residents of Harrisburg-Carlisle-Lebanon. In 2001 net earnings accounted for 67.1 percent of TPI (compared with 67.2 in 1991); dividends, interest, and rent were 17.9 percent (compared with 19.2 in 1991); and personal current transfer receipts were 15.0 percent (compared with 13.6 in 1991). From 2000 to 2001 net earnings increased 0.9 percent; dividends, interest, and rent decreased 0.9 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased 9.0 percent. From 1991 to 2001 net earnings increased on average 4.4 percent each year; dividends, interest, and rent increased on average 3.7 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased on average 5.4 percent.

#### **EARNINGS BY PLACE OF WORK**

Earnings of persons employed in Harrisburg-Carlisle-Lebanon increased from \$41,262,202\* in 2000 to \$41,703,040\* in 2001, an increase of 1.1 percent. The 2000-2001 national change was 3.1 percent. The average annual growth rate from the 1991 estimate of \$27,256,373\* to the 2001 estimate was 4.3 percent. The average annual growth rate for the nation was 5.8 percent.
