



## **BEARFACTS 1991 – 2001**

### **Killeen-Temple-Fort Hood (BEA-EA) [57087]**

Killeen-Temple-Fort Hood is one of 179 BEA Economic Areas in the nation. Its 2001 population of 608,306 ranked 102nd in the nation.

#### **PER CAPITA PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2001 Killeen-Temple-Fort Hood had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$22,835. This PCPI ranked 155th in the United States and was 75 percent of the national average, \$30,582. The 2001 PCPI reflected an increase of 3.1 percent from 2000. The 2000-2001 national change was 2.5 percent. In 1991 the PCPI of Killeen-Temple-Fort Hood was \$14,740 and ranked 158th in the United States. The 1991-2001 average annual growth rate of PCPI was 4.5 percent. The average annual growth rate for the nation was 4.4 percent.

#### **TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2001 Killeen-Temple-Fort Hood had a total personal income (TPI) of \$13,890,698\*. This TPI ranked 104th in the United States. In 1991 the TPI of Killeen-Temple-Fort Hood was \$7,546,391\* and ranked 112th in the United States. The 2001 TPI reflected an increase of 3.8 percent from 2000. The 2000-2001 national change was 3.5 percent. The 1991-2001 average annual growth rate of TPI was 6.3 percent. The average annual growth rate for the nation was 5.6 percent.

#### **COMPONENTS OF TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

Total personal income includes net earnings by place of residence; dividends, interest, and rent; and personal current transfer receipts received by the residents of Killeen-Temple-Fort Hood. In 2001 net earnings accounted for 69.5 percent of TPI (compared with 67.3 in 1991); dividends, interest, and rent were 15.6 percent (compared with 18.2 in 1991); and personal current transfer receipts were 14.9 percent (compared with 14.5 in 1991). From 2000 to 2001 net earnings increased 3.1 percent; dividends, interest, and rent increased 1.3 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased 9.6 percent. From 1991 to 2001 net earnings increased on average 6.6 percent each year; dividends, interest, and rent increased on average 4.6 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased on average 6.6 percent.

#### **EARNINGS BY PLACE OF WORK**

Earnings of persons employed in Killeen-Temple-Fort Hood increased from \$10,226,931\* in 2000 to \$10,596,663\* in 2001, an increase of 3.6 percent. The 2000-2001 national change was 3.1 percent. The average annual growth rate from the 1991 estimate of \$5,671,543\* to the 2001 estimate was 6.5 percent. The average annual growth rate for the nation was 5.8 percent.
