



BEARFACTS 1992 – 2002

Bristol Bay Borough , Alaska [02060]

Bristol Bay Borough is one of 27 counties in Alaska. It is not part of a Metropolitan Area. Its 2002 population of 1,136 ranked 26th in the state.

PER CAPITA PERSONAL INCOME

In 2002 Bristol Bay Borough had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$37,680. This PCPI ranked 2nd in the state and was 117 percent of the state average, \$32,258, and 122 percent of the national average, \$30,838. The 2002 PCPI reflected an increase of 0.3 percent from 2001. The 2001-2002 state change was 1.9 percent and the national change was 0.8 percent. In 1992 the PCPI of Bristol Bay Borough was \$32,014 and ranked 1st in the state. The 1992-2002 average annual growth rate of PCPI was 1.6 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 3.1 percent and for the nation was 4.0 percent.

TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME

In 2002 Bristol Bay Borough had a total personal income (TPI) of \$42,804*. This TPI ranked 25th in the state and accounted for 0.2 percent of the state total. In 1992 the TPI of Bristol Bay Borough was \$49,525* and ranked 24th in the state. The 2002 TPI reflected a decrease of 3.5 percent from 2001. The 2001-2002 state change was 3.4 percent and the national change was 1.8 percent. The 1992-2002 average annual growth rate of TPI was - 1.4 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 4.0 percent and for the nation was 5.2 percent.

COMPONENTS OF TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME

Total personal income includes net earnings by place of residence; dividends, interest, and rent; and personal current transfer receipts received by the residents of Bristol Bay Borough. In 2002 net earnings accounted for 67.9 percent of TPI (compared with 81.8 in 1992); dividends, interest, and rent were 13.7 percent (compared with 11.0 in 1992); and personal current transfer receipts were 18.5 percent (compared with 7.2 in 1992). From 2001 to 2002 net earnings decreased 4.4 percent; dividends, interest, and rent decreased 18.1 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased 15.6 percent. From 1992 to 2002 net earnings decreased on average 3.3 percent each year; dividends, interest, and rent increased on average 0.7 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased on average 8.3 percent.

EARNINGS BY PLACE OF WORK

Earnings of persons employed in Bristol Bay Borough decreased from \$55,416* in 2001 to \$54,760* in 2002, a decrease of 1.2 percent. The 2001-2002 state change was 5.1 percent and the national change was 2.1 percent. The average annual growth rate from the 1992 estimate of \$62,554* to the 2002 estimate was - 1.3 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 3.4 percent and for the nation was 5.4 percent.
