



BEARFACTS 1992 – 2002

Juneau City and Borough , Alaska [02110]

Juneau City and Borough is one of 27 counties in Alaska. It is part of the Juneau, AK Micropolitan SA. Its 2002 population of 30,706 ranked 5th in the state.

PER CAPITA PERSONAL INCOME

In 2002 Juneau City and Borough had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$34,817. This PCPI ranked 6th in the state and was 108 percent of the state average, \$32,258, and 113 percent of the national average, \$30,838. The 2002 PCPI reflected a decrease of 1.9 percent from 2001. The 2001-2002 state change was 1.9 percent and the national change was 0.8 percent. In 1992 the PCPI of Juneau City and Borough was \$28,763 and ranked 2nd in the state. The 1992-2002 average annual growth rate of PCPI was 1.9 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 3.1 percent and for the nation was 4.0 percent.

TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME

In 2002 Juneau City and Borough had a total personal income (TPI) of \$1,069,090*. This TPI ranked 5th in the state and accounted for 5.2 percent of the state total. In 1992 the TPI of Juneau City and Borough was \$818,218* and ranked 5th in the state. The 2002 TPI reflected a decrease of 1.2 percent from 2001. The 2001-2002 state change was 3.4 percent and the national change was 1.8 percent. The 1992-2002 average annual growth rate of TPI was 2.7 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 4.0 percent and for the nation was 5.2 percent.

COMPONENTS OF TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME

Total personal income includes net earnings by place of residence; dividends, interest, and rent; and personal current transfer receipts received by the residents of Juneau City and Borough. In 2002 net earnings accounted for 69.7 percent of TPI (compared with 72.0 in 1992); dividends, interest, and rent were 16.8 percent (compared with 18.7 in 1992); and personal current transfer receipts were 13.5 percent (compared with 9.3 in 1992). From 2001 to 2002 net earnings increased 1.3 percent; dividends, interest, and rent decreased 11.7 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased 1.0 percent. From 1992 to 2002 net earnings increased on average 2.4 percent each year; dividends, interest, and rent increased on average 1.6 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased on average 6.6 percent.

EARNINGS BY PLACE OF WORK

Earnings of persons employed in Juneau City and Borough increased from \$824,716* in 2001 to \$834,470* in 2002, an increase of 1.2 percent. The 2001-2002 state change was 5.1 percent and the national change was 2.1 percent. The average annual growth rate from the 1992 estimate of \$651,165* to the 2002 estimate was 2.5 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 3.4 percent and for the nation was 5.4 percent.
