



BEARFACTS 1992 – 2002

Yakutat City and Borough , Alaska [02282]

Yakutat City and Borough[†] is one of 27 counties in Alaska. It is not part of a Metropolitan Area. Its 2002 population of 749 ranked 27th in the state.

PER CAPITA PERSONAL INCOME

In 2002 Yakutat City and Borough had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$31,236. This PCPI ranked 9th in the state and was 97 percent of the state average, \$32,258, and 101 percent of the national average, \$30,838. The 2002 PCPI reflected an increase of 9.5 percent from 2001. The 2001-2002 state change was 1.9 percent and the national change was 0.8 percent.

TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME

In 2002 Yakutat City and Borough had a total personal income (TPI) of \$23,396*. This TPI ranked 27th in the state and accounted for 0.1 percent of the state total. The 2002 TPI reflected an increase of 2.7 percent from 2001. The 2001-2002 state change was 3.4 percent and the national change was 1.8 percent.

COMPONENTS OF TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME

Total personal income includes net earnings by place of residence; dividends, interest, and rent; and personal current transfer receipts received by the residents of Yakutat City and Borough. In 2002 net earnings accounted for 62.2 percent of TPI; dividends, interest, and rent were 16.3 percent; and personal current transfer receipts were 21.5 percent. From 2001 to 2002 net earnings increased 7.9 percent; dividends, interest, and rent decreased 13.8 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased 3.2 percent. From 1992 to 2002 net earnings cannot be calculated; the growth rate for dividends, interest, and rent cannot be calculated; the growth rate for personal current transfer receipts cannot be calculated.

EARNINGS BY PLACE OF WORK

Earnings of persons employed in Yakutat City and Borough increased from \$14,472* in 2001 to \$15,473* in 2002, an increase of 6.9 percent. The 2001-2002 state change was 5.1 percent and the national change was 2.1 percent.
