



BEARFACTS 1992 – 2002

Arthur , Nebraska [31005]

Arthur is one of 93 counties in Nebraska. It is not part of a Metropolitan Area. Its 2002 population of 394 ranked 93rd in the state.

PER CAPITA PERSONAL INCOME

In 2002 Arthur had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$12,360. This PCPI ranked 89th in the state and was 42 percent of the state average, \$29,225, and 40 percent of the national average, \$30,838. The 2002 PCPI reflected an increase of 19.4 percent from 2001. The 2001-2002 state change was 1.8 percent and the national change was 0.8 percent. In 1992 the PCPI of Arthur was \$10,872 and ranked 89th in the state. The 1992-2002 average annual growth rate of PCPI was 1.3 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 4.2 percent and for the nation was 4.0 percent.

TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME

In 2002 Arthur had a total personal income (TPI) of \$4,870*. This TPI ranked 93rd in the state and accounted for 0.0 percent of the state total. In 1992 the TPI of Arthur was \$5,023* and ranked 92nd in the state. The 2002 TPI reflected an increase of 15.0 percent from 2001. The 2001-2002 state change was 2.2 percent and the national change was 1.8 percent. The 1992-2002 average annual growth rate of TPI was - 0.3 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 4.9 percent and for the nation was 5.2 percent.

COMPONENTS OF TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME

Total personal income includes net earnings by place of residence; dividends, interest, and rent; and personal current transfer receipts received by the residents of Arthur. From 2001 to 2002 dividends, interest, and rent increased 10.1 percent; and personal current transfer receipts decreased 4.2 percent. From 1992 to 2002 net earnings cannot be calculated; dividends, interest, and rent increased on average 6.1 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased on average 5.4 percent.

EARNINGS BY PLACE OF WORK

Earnings of persons employed in Arthur increased from \$- 1,801* in 2001 to \$- 1,449* in 2002. The 2001-2002 state change was 2.2 percent and the national change was 2.1 percent. The average annual growth rate from the 1992 estimate of \$1,755* to the 2002 estimate cannot be calculated. The average annual growth rate for the state was 4.8 percent and for the nation was 5.4 percent.
