



## **BEARFACTS 1992 – 2002**

### **Sacramento-Arden-Arcade-Roseville (MSA) [40900]**

Sacramento-Arden-Arcade-Roseville is one of 363 Metropolitan Statistical Areas (MSAs) in the nation. Its 2002 population of 1,925,437 ranked 26th in the nation.

#### **PER CAPITA PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2002 Sacramento-Arden-Arcade-Roseville had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$31,008. This PCPI ranked 79th in the United States and was 101 percent of the national average, \$30,821. The 2002 PCPI reflected an increase of 0.7 percent from 2001. The 2001-2002 national change was 0.8 percent. In 1992 the PCPI of Sacramento-Arden-Arcade-Roseville was \$21,028 and ranked 77th in the United States. The 1992-2002 average annual growth rate of PCPI was 4.0 percent. The average annual growth rate for the nation was 4.0 percent.

#### **TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2002 Sacramento-Arden-Arcade-Roseville had a total personal income (TPI) of \$59,704,347\*. This TPI ranked 28th in the United States. In 1992 the TPI of Sacramento-Arden-Arcade-Roseville was \$33,463,711\* and ranked 28th in the United States. The 2002 TPI reflected an increase of 3.8 percent from 2001. The 2001-2002 national change was 1.8 percent. The 1992-2002 average annual growth rate of TPI was 6.0 percent. The average annual growth rate for the nation was 5.2 percent.

#### **COMPONENTS OF TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

Total personal income includes net earnings by place of residence; dividends, interest, and rent; and personal current transfer receipts received by the residents of Sacramento-Arden-Arcade-Roseville. In 2002 net earnings accounted for 70.3 percent of TPI (compared with 67.9 in 1992); dividends, interest, and rent were 15.3 percent (compared with 17.2 in 1992); and personal current transfer receipts were 14.4 percent (compared with 15.0 in 1992). From 2001 to 2002 net earnings increased 5.7 percent; dividends, interest, and rent decreased 6.4 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased 6.5 percent. From 1992 to 2002 net earnings increased on average 6.3 percent each year; dividends, interest, and rent increased on average 4.8 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased on average 5.5 percent.

#### **EARNINGS BY PLACE OF WORK**

Earnings of persons employed in Sacramento-Arden-Arcade-Roseville increased from \$44,540,173\* in 2001 to \$47,254,444\* in 2002, an increase of 6.1 percent. The 2001-2002 national change was 2.1 percent. The average annual growth rate from the 1992 estimate of \$25,367,958\* to the 2002 estimate was 6.4 percent. The average annual growth rate for the nation was 5.4 percent.
