



## **BEARFACTS 1992 – 2002**

### **Saginaw-Saginaw Township North (MSA) [40980]**

Saginaw-Saginaw Township North is one of 363 Metropolitan Statistical Areas (MSAs) in the nation. Its 2002 population of 209,042 ranked 190th in the nation.

#### **PER CAPITA PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2002 Saginaw-Saginaw Township North had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$25,299. This PCPI ranked 240th in the United States and was 82 percent of the national average, \$30,838. The 2002 PCPI reflected a decrease of 1.1 percent from 2001. The 2001-2002 national change was 0.8 percent. In 1992 the PCPI of Saginaw-Saginaw Township North was \$17,750 and ranked 220th in the United States. The 1992-2002 average annual growth rate of PCPI was 3.6 percent. The average annual growth rate for the nation was 4.0 percent.

#### **TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2002 Saginaw-Saginaw Township North had a total personal income (TPI) of \$5,288,616\*. This TPI ranked 194th in the United States. In 1992 the TPI of Saginaw-Saginaw Township North was \$3,770,561\* and ranked 177th in the United States. The 2002 TPI reflected a decrease of 1.3 percent from 2001. The 2001-2002 national change was 1.8 percent. The 1992-2002 average annual growth rate of TPI was 3.4 percent. The average annual growth rate for the nation was 5.2 percent.

#### **COMPONENTS OF TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

Total personal income includes net earnings by place of residence; dividends, interest, and rent; and personal current transfer receipts received by the residents of Saginaw-Saginaw Township North. In 2002 net earnings accounted for 65.8 percent of TPI (compared with 64.7 in 1992); dividends, interest, and rent were 13.6 percent (compared with 17.3 in 1992); and personal current transfer receipts were 20.6 percent (compared with 18.0 in 1992). From 2001 to 2002 net earnings decreased 0.1 percent; dividends, interest, and rent decreased 12.6 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased 3.7 percent. From 1992 to 2002 net earnings increased on average 3.6 percent each year; dividends, interest, and rent increased on average 1.0 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased on average 4.8 percent.

#### **EARNINGS BY PLACE OF WORK**

Earnings of persons employed in Saginaw-Saginaw Township North decreased from \$4,621,316\* in 2001 to \$4,607,995\* in 2002, a decrease of 0.3 percent. The 2001-2002 national change was 2.1 percent. The average annual growth rate from the 1992 estimate of \$3,204,932\* to the 2002 estimate was 3.7 percent. The average annual growth rate for the nation was 5.4 percent.
