



BEARFACTS 1992 – 2002

Montague , Texas [48337]

Montague is one of 254 counties in Texas. It is not part of a Metropolitan Area. Its 2002 population of 19,122 ranked 118th in the state.

PER CAPITA PERSONAL INCOME

In 2002 Montague had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$22,570. This PCPI ranked 122nd in the state and was 78 percent of the state average, \$28,858, and 73 percent of the national average, \$30,838. The 2002 PCPI reflected an increase of 0.3 percent from 2001. The 2001-2002 state change was -0.6 percent and the national change was 0.8 percent. In 1992 the PCPI of Montague was \$15,254 and ranked 141st in the state. The 1992-2002 average annual growth rate of PCPI was 4.0 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 4.3 percent and for the nation was 4.0 percent.

TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME

In 2002 Montague had a total personal income (TPI) of \$431,584*. This TPI ranked 119th in the state and accounted for 0.1 percent of the state total. In 1992 the TPI of Montague was \$265,478* and ranked 118th in the state. The 2002 TPI remained unchanged from 2001. The 2001-2002 state change was 1.1 percent and the national change was 1.8 percent. The 1992-2002 average annual growth rate of TPI was 5.0 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 6.4 percent and for the nation was 5.2 percent.

COMPONENTS OF TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME

Total personal income includes net earnings by place of residence; dividends, interest, and rent; and personal current transfer receipts received by the residents of Montague. In 2002 net earnings accounted for 57.1 percent of TPI (compared with 52.6 in 1992); dividends, interest, and rent were 17.3 percent (compared with 22.0 in 1992); and personal current transfer receipts were 25.6 percent (compared with 25.3 in 1992). From 2001 to 2002 net earnings increased 0.5 percent; dividends, interest, and rent decreased 11.3 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased 8.3 percent. From 1992 to 2002 net earnings increased on average 5.8 percent each year; dividends, interest, and rent increased on average 2.5 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased on average 5.1 percent.

EARNINGS BY PLACE OF WORK

Earnings of persons employed in Montague decreased from \$165,793* in 2001 to \$164,386* in 2002, a decrease of 0.8 percent. The 2001-2002 state change was 1.0 percent and the national change was 2.1 percent. The average annual growth rate from the 1992 estimate of \$121,459* to the 2002 estimate was 3.1 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 6.8 percent and for the nation was 5.4 percent.
