



## **BEARFACTS 1992 – 2002**

### **Nolan , Texas [48353]**

Nolan is one of 254 counties in Texas. It is part of the Sweetwater, TX Micropolitan SA. Its 2002 population of 15,046 ranked 138th in the state.

#### **PER CAPITA PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2002 Nolan had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$21,236. This PCPI ranked 164th in the state and was 74 percent of the state average, \$28,858, and 69 percent of the national average, \$30,838. The 2002 PCPI reflected an increase of 1.7 percent from 2001. The 2001-2002 state change was -0.6 percent and the national change was 0.8 percent. In 1992 the PCPI of Nolan was \$14,913 and ranked 163rd in the state. The 1992-2002 average annual growth rate of PCPI was 3.6 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 4.3 percent and for the nation was 4.0 percent.

#### **TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2002 Nolan had a total personal income (TPI) of \$319,515\*. This TPI ranked 136th in the state and accounted for 0.1 percent of the state total. In 1992 the TPI of Nolan was \$239,992\* and ranked 125th in the state. The 2002 TPI reflected a decrease of 0.3 percent from 2001. The 2001-2002 state change was 1.1 percent and the national change was 1.8 percent. The 1992-2002 average annual growth rate of TPI was 2.9 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 6.4 percent and for the nation was 5.2 percent.

#### **COMPONENTS OF TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

Total personal income includes net earnings by place of residence; dividends, interest, and rent; and personal current transfer receipts received by the residents of Nolan. In 2002 net earnings accounted for 56.1 percent of TPI (compared with 57.4 in 1992); dividends, interest, and rent were 15.7 percent (compared with 18.4 in 1992); and personal current transfer receipts were 28.2 percent (compared with 24.2 in 1992). From 2001 to 2002 net earnings increased 0.3 percent; dividends, interest, and rent decreased 13.8 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased 7.9 percent. From 1992 to 2002 net earnings increased on average 2.7 percent each year; dividends, interest, and rent increased on average 1.3 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased on average 4.5 percent.

#### **EARNINGS BY PLACE OF WORK**

Earnings of persons employed in Nolan remained unchanged. The 2001-2002 state change was 1.0 percent and the national change was 2.1 percent. The average annual growth rate from the 1992 estimate of \$159,920\* to the 2002 estimate was 2.8 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 6.8 percent and for the nation was 5.4 percent.

*\*Note: All income estimates with the exception of PCPI are in thousands of dollars, not adjusted for inflation.*
