



BEARFACTS 1992 – 2002

Terrell , Texas [48443]

Terrell is one of 254 counties in Texas. It is not part of a Metropolitan Area. Its 2002 population of 1,025 ranked 247th in the state.

PER CAPITA PERSONAL INCOME

In 2002 Terrell had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$28,068. This PCPI ranked 30th in the state and was 97 percent of the state average, \$28,858, and 91 percent of the national average, \$30,838. The 2002 PCPI reflected a decrease of 3.1 percent from 2001. The 2001-2002 state change was -0.6 percent and the national change was 0.8 percent. In 1992 the PCPI of Terrell was \$18,394 and ranked 47th in the state. The 1992-2002 average annual growth rate of PCPI was 4.3 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 4.3 percent and for the nation was 4.0 percent.

TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME

In 2002 Terrell had a total personal income (TPI) of \$28,770*. This TPI ranked 244th in the state and accounted for 0.0 percent of the state total. In 1992 the TPI of Terrell was \$24,519* and ranked 246th in the state. The 2002 TPI reflected a decrease of 3.1 percent from 2001. The 2001-2002 state change was 1.1 percent and the national change was 1.8 percent. The 1992-2002 average annual growth rate of TPI was 1.6 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 6.4 percent and for the nation was 5.2 percent.

COMPONENTS OF TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME

Total personal income includes net earnings by place of residence; dividends, interest, and rent; and personal current transfer receipts received by the residents of Terrell. In 2002 net earnings accounted for 55.0 percent of TPI (compared with 55.3 in 1992); dividends, interest, and rent were 24.8 percent (compared with 29.5 in 1992); and personal current transfer receipts were 20.2 percent (compared with 15.1 in 1992). From 2001 to 2002 net earnings increased 2.6 percent; dividends, interest, and rent decreased 19.7 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased 7.6 percent. From 1992 to 2002 net earnings increased on average 1.6 percent each year; dividends, interest, and rent decreased on average 0.2 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased on average 4.6 percent.

EARNINGS BY PLACE OF WORK

Earnings of persons employed in Terrell decreased from \$15,566* in 2001 to \$15,550* in 2002, a decrease of 0.1 percent. The 2001-2002 state change was 1.0 percent and the national change was 2.1 percent. The average annual growth rate from the 1992 estimate of \$16,001* to the 2002 estimate was - 0.3 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 6.8 percent and for the nation was 5.4 percent.
