



## **BEARFACTS 1992 – 2002**

### **Uvalde , Texas [48463]**

Uvalde is one of 254 counties in Texas. It is part of the Uvalde, TX Micropolitan SA. Its 2002 population of 26,404 ranked 95th in the state.

#### **PER CAPITA PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2002 Uvalde had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$19,739. This PCPI ranked 195th in the state and was 68 percent of the state average, \$28,858, and 64 percent of the national average, \$30,838. The 2002 PCPI reflected an increase of 1.5 percent from 2001. The 2001-2002 state change was -0.6 percent and the national change was 0.8 percent. In 1992 the PCPI of Uvalde was \$13,105 and ranked 222nd in the state. The 1992-2002 average annual growth rate of PCPI was 4.2 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 4.3 percent and for the nation was 4.0 percent.

#### **TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2002 Uvalde had a total personal income (TPI) of \$521,192\*. This TPI ranked 103rd in the state and accounted for 0.1 percent of the state total. In 1992 the TPI of Uvalde was \$313,815\* and ranked 107th in the state. The 2002 TPI reflected an increase of 3.1 percent from 2001. The 2001-2002 state change was 1.1 percent and the national change was 1.8 percent. The 1992-2002 average annual growth rate of TPI was 5.2 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 6.4 percent and for the nation was 5.2 percent.

#### **COMPONENTS OF TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

Total personal income includes net earnings by place of residence; dividends, interest, and rent; and personal current transfer receipts received by the residents of Uvalde. In 2002 net earnings accounted for 54.3 percent of TPI (compared with 56.0 in 1992); dividends, interest, and rent were 20.3 percent (compared with 21.7 in 1992); and personal current transfer receipts were 25.4 percent (compared with 22.4 in 1992). From 2001 to 2002 net earnings increased 3.3 percent; dividends, interest, and rent decreased 5.4 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased 10.5 percent. From 1992 to 2002 net earnings increased on average 4.9 percent each year; dividends, interest, and rent increased on average 4.5 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased on average 6.6 percent.

#### **EARNINGS BY PLACE OF WORK**

Earnings of persons employed in Uvalde increased from \$302,840\* in 2001 to \$312,793\* in 2002, an increase of 3.3 percent. The 2001-2002 state change was 1.0 percent and the national change was 2.1 percent. The average annual growth rate from the 1992 estimate of \$192,038\* to the 2002 estimate was 5.0 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 6.8 percent and for the nation was 5.4 percent.
