



## **BEARFACTS 1992 – 2002**

### **Calumet , Wisconsin [55015]**

Calumet is one of 72 counties in Wisconsin. It is part of the [Appleton, WI \(MSA\)](#). Its 2002 population of 42,523 ranked 33rd in the state.

#### **PER CAPITA PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2002 Calumet had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$31,409. This PCPI ranked 5th in the state and was 105 percent of the state average, \$29,994, and 102 percent of the national average, \$30,838. The 2002 PCPI reflected an increase of 4.9 percent from 2001. The 2001-2002 state change was 2.1 percent and the national change was 0.8 percent. In 1992 the PCPI of Calumet was \$19,049 and ranked 16th in the state. The 1992-2002 average annual growth rate of PCPI was 5.1 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 4.3 percent and for the nation was 4.0 percent.

#### **TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2002 Calumet had a total personal income (TPI) of \$1,335,608\*. This TPI ranked 28th in the state and accounted for 0.8 percent of the state total. In 1992 the TPI of Calumet was \$676,294\* and ranked 30th in the state. The 2002 TPI reflected an increase of 7.6 percent from 2001. The 2001-2002 state change was 2.8 percent and the national change was 1.8 percent. The 1992-2002 average annual growth rate of TPI was 7.0 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 5.1 percent and for the nation was 5.2 percent.

#### **COMPONENTS OF TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

Total personal income includes net earnings by place of residence; dividends, interest, and rent; and personal current transfer receipts received by the residents of Calumet. In 2002 net earnings accounted for 74.4 percent of TPI (compared with 71.3 in 1992); dividends, interest, and rent were 16.4 percent (compared with 18.7 in 1992); and personal current transfer receipts were 9.2 percent (compared with 10.0 in 1992). From 2001 to 2002 net earnings increased 8.7 percent; dividends, interest, and rent increased 2.0 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased 10.1 percent. From 1992 to 2002 net earnings increased on average 7.5 percent each year; dividends, interest, and rent increased on average 5.6 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased on average 6.2 percent.

#### **EARNINGS BY PLACE OF WORK**

Earnings of persons employed in Calumet increased from \$513,959\* in 2001 to \$543,677\* in 2002, an increase of 5.8 percent. The 2001-2002 state change was 3.4 percent and the national change was 2.1 percent. The average annual growth rate from the 1992 estimate of \$318,057\* to the 2002 estimate was 5.5 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 5.2 percent and for the nation was 5.4 percent.

*\*Note: All income estimates with the exception of PCPI are in thousands of dollars, not adjusted for inflation.*
