



## **BEARFACTS 1993 – 2003 Mono , California [06051]**

Mono is one of 58 counties in California. It is not part of a Metropolitan Area. Its 2003 population of 12,938 ranked 55th in the state.

### **PER CAPITA PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2003 Mono had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$31,641. This PCPI ranked 18th in the state and was 94 percent of the state average, \$33,554, and 100 percent of the national average, \$31,504. The 2003 PCPI reflected an increase of 13.0 percent from 2002. The 2002-2003 state change was 2.2 percent and the national change was 2.2 percent. In 1993 the PCPI of Mono was \$19,279 and ranked 24th in the state. The 1993-2003 average annual growth rate of PCPI was 5.1 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 4.0 percent and for the nation was 4.0 percent.

### **TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2003 Mono had a total personal income (TPI) of \$409,366\*. This TPI ranked 54th in the state and accounted for 0.0 percent of the state total. In 1993 the TPI of Mono was \$210,466\* and ranked 54th in the state. The 2003 TPI reflected an increase of 11.8 percent from 2002. The 2002-2003 state change was 3.4 percent and the national change was 3.1 percent. The 1993-2003 average annual growth rate of TPI was 6.9 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 5.3 percent and for the nation was 5.1 percent.

### **COMPONENTS OF TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

Total personal income includes net earnings by place of residence; dividends, interest, and rent; and personal current transfer receipts received by the residents of Mono. In 2003 net earnings accounted for 72.8 percent of TPI (compared with 72.0 in 1993); dividends, interest, and rent were 19.3 percent (compared with 19.5 in 1993); and personal current transfer receipts were 7.9 percent (compared with 8.4 in 1993). From 2002 to 2003 net earnings increased 13.9 percent; dividends, interest, and rent increased 7.0 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased 5.5 percent. From 1993 to 2003 net earnings increased on average 7.0 percent each year; dividends, interest, and rent increased on average 6.7 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased on average 6.2 percent.

### **EARNINGS BY PLACE OF WORK**

Earnings of persons employed in Mono increased from \$276,597\* in 2002 to \$319,872\* in 2003, an increase of 15.6 percent. The 2002-2003 state change was 4.0 percent and the national change was 3.8 percent. The average annual growth rate from the 1993 estimate of \$171,183\* to the 2003 estimate was 6.5 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 5.6 percent and for the nation was 5.3 percent.
