



## **BEARFACTS 1993 – 2003**

### **Crowley , Colorado [08025]**

Crowley is one of 64 counties in Colorado. It is not part of a Metropolitan Area. Its 2003 population of 5,634 ranked 49th in the state.

#### **PER CAPITA PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2003 Crowley had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$15,338. This PCPI ranked 64th in the state and was 45 percent of the state average, \$33,989, and 49 percent of the national average, \$31,504. The 2003 PCPI reflected an increase of 3.5 percent from 2002. The 2002-2003 state change was 0.1 percent and the national change was 2.2 percent. In 1993 the PCPI of Crowley was \$12,716 and ranked 62nd in the state. The 1993-2003 average annual growth rate of PCPI was 1.9 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 4.4 percent and for the nation was 4.0 percent.

#### **TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2003 Crowley had a total personal income (TPI) of \$86,414\*. This TPI ranked 55th in the state and accounted for 0.1 percent of the state total. In 1993 the TPI of Crowley was \$55,021\* and ranked 52nd in the state. The 2003 TPI reflected an increase of 0.6 percent from 2002. The 2002-2003 state change was 1.2 percent and the national change was 3.1 percent. The 1993-2003 average annual growth rate of TPI was 4.6 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 6.9 percent and for the nation was 5.1 percent.

#### **COMPONENTS OF TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

Total personal income includes net earnings by place of residence; dividends, interest, and rent; and personal current transfer receipts received by the residents of Crowley. In 2003 net earnings accounted for 57.7 percent of TPI (compared with 61.8 in 1993); dividends, interest, and rent were 16.0 percent (compared with 14.2 in 1993); and personal current transfer receipts were 26.4 percent (compared with 24.0 in 1993). From 2002 to 2003 net earnings decreased 1.4 percent; dividends, interest, and rent increased 4.0 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased 3.2 percent. From 1993 to 2003 net earnings increased on average 3.9 percent each year; dividends, interest, and rent increased on average 5.9 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased on average 5.6 percent.

#### **EARNINGS BY PLACE OF WORK**

Earnings of persons employed in Crowley decreased from \$58,430\* in 2002 to \$57,690\* in 2003, a decrease of 1.3 percent. The 2002-2003 state change was 1.3 percent and the national change was 3.8 percent. The average annual growth rate from the 1993 estimate of \$40,288\* to the 2003 estimate was 3.7 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 7.1 percent and for the nation was 5.3 percent.

*\*Note: All income estimates with the exception of PCPI are in thousands of dollars, not adjusted for inflation.*
