



BEARFACTS 1993 – 2003

St. Landry , Louisiana [22097]

St. Landry is one of 64 counties in Louisiana. It is part of the Opelousas-Eunice, LA Micropolitan SA. Its 2003 population of 87,957 ranked 15th in the state.

PER CAPITA PERSONAL INCOME

In 2003 St. Landry had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$19,599. This PCPI ranked 50th in the state and was 76 percent of the state average, \$25,862, and 62 percent of the national average, \$31,530. The 2003 PCPI reflected an increase of 2.2 percent from 2002. The 2002-2003 state change was 2.4 percent and the national change was 2.2 percent. In 1993 the PCPI of St. Landry was \$13,652 and ranked 45th in the state. The 1993-2003 average annual growth rate of PCPI was 3.7 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 4.0 percent and for the nation was 4.0 percent.

TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME

In 2003 St. Landry had a total personal income (TPI) of \$1,723,874*. This TPI ranked 17th in the state and accounted for 1.5 percent of the state total. In 1993 the TPI of St. Landry was \$1,126,375* and ranked 15th in the state. The 2003 TPI reflected an increase of 2.4 percent from 2002. The 2002-2003 state change was 2.6 percent and the national change was 3.1 percent. The 1993-2003 average annual growth rate of TPI was 4.3 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 4.4 percent and for the nation was 5.1 percent.

COMPONENTS OF TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME

Total personal income includes net earnings by place of residence; dividends, interest, and rent; and personal current transfer receipts received by the residents of St. Landry. In 2003 net earnings accounted for 59.8 percent of TPI (compared with 56.4 in 1993); dividends, interest, and rent were 11.4 percent (compared with 14.3 in 1993); and personal current transfer receipts were 28.8 percent (compared with 29.4 in 1993). From 2002 to 2003 net earnings increased 6.7 percent; dividends, interest, and rent decreased 9.7 percent; and personal current transfer receipts decreased 0.6 percent. From 1993 to 2003 net earnings increased on average 5.0 percent each year; dividends, interest, and rent increased on average 2.0 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased on average 4.2 percent.

EARNINGS BY PLACE OF WORK

Earnings of persons employed in St. Landry increased from \$778,926* in 2002 to \$864,753* in 2003, an increase of 11.0 percent. The 2002-2003 state change was 4.4 percent and the national change was 3.8 percent. The average annual growth rate from the 1993 estimate of \$572,158* to the 2003 estimate was 4.2 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 4.7 percent and for the nation was 5.3 percent.
