



## **BEARFACTS 1993 – 2003**

### **Stanton , Nebraska [31167]**

Stanton is one of 93 counties in Nebraska. It is part of the Norfolk, NE Micropolitan SA. Its 2003 population of 6,487 ranked 48th in the state.

#### **PER CAPITA PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2003 Stanton had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$23,773. This PCPI ranked 76th in the state and was 77 percent of the state average, \$30,778, and 75 percent of the national average, \$31,504. The 2003 PCPI reflected an increase of 13.5 percent from 2002. The 2002-2003 state change was 5.4 percent and the national change was 2.2 percent. In 1993 the PCPI of Stanton was \$17,134 and ranked 57th in the state. The 1993-2003 average annual growth rate of PCPI was 3.3 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 4.5 percent and for the nation was 4.0 percent.

#### **TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2003 Stanton had a total personal income (TPI) of \$154,218\*. This TPI ranked 53rd in the state and accounted for 0.3 percent of the state total. In 1993 the TPI of Stanton was \$106,897\* and ranked 52nd in the state. The 2003 TPI reflected an increase of 13.4 percent from 2002. The 2002-2003 state change was 6.0 percent and the national change was 3.1 percent. The 1993-2003 average annual growth rate of TPI was 3.7 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 5.2 percent and for the nation was 5.1 percent.

#### **COMPONENTS OF TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

Total personal income includes net earnings by place of residence; dividends, interest, and rent; and personal current transfer receipts received by the residents of Stanton. In 2003 net earnings accounted for 77.9 percent of TPI (compared with 75.6 in 1993); dividends, interest, and rent were 9.3 percent (compared with 15.5 in 1993); and personal current transfer receipts were 12.8 percent (compared with 8.9 in 1993). From 2002 to 2003 net earnings increased 17.8 percent; dividends, interest, and rent decreased 1.4 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased 1.5 percent. From 1993 to 2003 net earnings increased on average 4.0 percent each year; dividends, interest, and rent decreased on average 1.4 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased on average 7.5 percent.

#### **EARNINGS BY PLACE OF WORK**

Earnings of persons employed in Stanton increased from \$72,736\* in 2002 to \$87,006\* in 2003, an increase of 19.6 percent. The 2002-2003 state change was 7.5 percent and the national change was 3.8 percent. The average annual growth rate from the 1993 estimate of \$77,235\* to the 2003 estimate was 1.2 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 5.2 percent and for the nation was 5.3 percent.
