



BEARFACTS 1993 – 2003

Vance , North Carolina [37181]

Vance is one of 100 counties in North Carolina. It is part of the Henderson, NC Micropolitan SA. Its 2003 population of 43,279 ranked 56th in the state.

PER CAPITA PERSONAL INCOME

In 2003 Vance had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$21,522. This PCPI ranked 78th in the state and was 77 percent of the state average, \$27,904, and 68 percent of the national average, \$31,504. The 2003 PCPI reflected an increase of 0.8 percent from 2002. The 2002-2003 state change was 1.5 percent and the national change was 2.2 percent. In 1993 the PCPI of Vance was \$16,388 and ranked 56th in the state. The 1993-2003 average annual growth rate of PCPI was 2.8 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 3.6 percent and for the nation was 4.0 percent.

TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME

In 2003 Vance had a total personal income (TPI) of \$931,446*. This TPI ranked 58th in the state and accounted for 0.4 percent of the state total. In 1993 the TPI of Vance was \$655,663* and ranked 53rd in the state. The 2003 TPI reflected an increase of 0.1 percent from 2002. The 2002-2003 state change was 2.8 percent and the national change was 3.1 percent. The 1993-2003 average annual growth rate of TPI was 3.6 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 5.5 percent and for the nation was 5.1 percent.

COMPONENTS OF TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME

Total personal income includes net earnings by place of residence; dividends, interest, and rent; and personal current transfer receipts received by the residents of Vance. In 2003 net earnings accounted for 59.6 percent of TPI (compared with 60.7 in 1993); dividends, interest, and rent were 12.8 percent (compared with 18.8 in 1993); and personal current transfer receipts were 27.7 percent (compared with 20.5 in 1993). From 2002 to 2003 net earnings decreased 0.2 percent; dividends, interest, and rent decreased 4.8 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased 3.2 percent. From 1993 to 2003 net earnings increased on average 3.4 percent each year; dividends, interest, and rent decreased on average 0.4 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased on average 6.8 percent.

EARNINGS BY PLACE OF WORK

Earnings of persons employed in Vance decreased from \$578,614* in 2002 to \$576,182* in 2003, a decrease of 0.4 percent. The 2002-2003 state change was 3.3 percent and the national change was 3.8 percent. The average annual growth rate from the 1993 estimate of \$457,899* to the 2003 estimate was 2.3 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 5.4 percent and for the nation was 5.3 percent.
