



## **BEARFACTS 1993 – 2003**

### **Ellis , Oklahoma [40045]**

Ellis is one of 77 counties in Oklahoma. It is not part of a Metropolitan Area. Its 2003 population of 3,909 ranked 73rd in the state.

#### **PER CAPITA PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2003 Ellis had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$24,827. This PCPI ranked 16th in the state and was 94 percent of the state average, \$26,486, and 79 percent of the national average, \$31,530. The 2003 PCPI reflected an increase of 9.7 percent from 2002. The 2002-2003 state change was 2.3 percent and the national change was 2.2 percent. In 1993 the PCPI of Ellis was \$17,533 and ranked 15th in the state. The 1993-2003 average annual growth rate of PCPI was 3.5 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 4.0 percent and for the nation was 4.0 percent.

#### **TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2003 Ellis had a total personal income (TPI) of \$97,047\*. This TPI ranked 73rd in the state and accounted for 0.1 percent of the state total. In 1993 the TPI of Ellis was \$75,375\* and ranked 73rd in the state. The 2003 TPI reflected an increase of 8.4 percent from 2002. The 2002-2003 state change was 2.7 percent and the national change was 3.1 percent. The 1993-2003 average annual growth rate of TPI was 2.6 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 4.8 percent and for the nation was 5.1 percent.

#### **COMPONENTS OF TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

Total personal income includes net earnings by place of residence; dividends, interest, and rent; and personal current transfer receipts received by the residents of Ellis. In 2003 net earnings accounted for 53.8 percent of TPI (compared with 53.1 in 1993); dividends, interest, and rent were 24.6 percent (compared with 28.8 in 1993); and personal current transfer receipts were 21.7 percent (compared with 18.1 in 1993). From 2002 to 2003 net earnings increased 17.0 percent; dividends, interest, and rent decreased 1.8 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased 1.9 percent. From 1993 to 2003 net earnings increased on average 2.7 percent each year; dividends, interest, and rent increased on average 0.9 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased on average 4.4 percent.

#### **EARNINGS BY PLACE OF WORK**

Earnings of persons employed in Ellis increased from \$38,121\* in 2002 to \$45,794\* in 2003, an increase of 20.1 percent. The 2002-2003 state change was 3.5 percent and the national change was 3.8 percent. The average annual growth rate from the 1993 estimate of \$38,857\* to the 2003 estimate was 1.7 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 4.7 percent and for the nation was 5.3 percent.
