



BEARFACTS 1993 – 2003

McCook , South Dakota [46087]

McCook is one of 66 counties in South Dakota. It is part of the [Sioux Falls, SD \(MSA\)](#). Its 2003 population of 5,801 ranked 32nd in the state.

PER CAPITA PERSONAL INCOME

In 2003 McCook had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$29,709. This PCPI ranked 21st in the state and was 102 percent of the state average, \$29,191, and 94 percent of the national average, \$31,504. The 2003 PCPI reflected an increase of 10.8 percent from 2002. The 2002-2003 state change was 8.0 percent and the national change was 2.2 percent. In 1993 the PCPI of McCook was \$16,352 and ranked 41st in the state. The 1993-2003 average annual growth rate of PCPI was 6.2 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 4.8 percent and for the nation was 4.0 percent.

TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME

In 2003 McCook had a total personal income (TPI) of \$172,344*. This TPI ranked 28th in the state and accounted for 0.8 percent of the state total. In 1993 the TPI of McCook was \$95,120* and ranked 31st in the state. The 2003 TPI reflected an increase of 11.0 percent from 2002. The 2002-2003 state change was 8.7 percent and the national change was 3.1 percent. The 1993-2003 average annual growth rate of TPI was 6.1 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 5.4 percent and for the nation was 5.1 percent.

COMPONENTS OF TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME

Total personal income includes net earnings by place of residence; dividends, interest, and rent; and personal current transfer receipts received by the residents of McCook. In 2003 net earnings accounted for 66.7 percent of TPI (compared with 59.8 in 1993); dividends, interest, and rent were 19.3 percent (compared with 22.5 in 1993); and personal current transfer receipts were 14.0 percent (compared with 17.7 in 1993). From 2002 to 2003 net earnings increased 16.6 percent; dividends, interest, and rent increased 1.4 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased 0.8 percent. From 1993 to 2003 net earnings increased on average 7.3 percent each year; dividends, interest, and rent increased on average 4.5 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased on average 3.7 percent.

EARNINGS BY PLACE OF WORK

Earnings of persons employed in McCook increased from \$63,696* in 2002 to \$78,721* in 2003, an increase of 23.6 percent. The 2002-2003 state change was 11.1 percent and the national change was 3.8 percent. The average annual growth rate from the 1993 estimate of \$48,877* to the 2003 estimate was 4.9 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 5.3 percent and for the nation was 5.3 percent.
