



BEARFACTS 1993 – 2003

Stanley , South Dakota [46117]

Stanley is one of 66 counties in South Dakota. It is part of the Pierre, SD Micropolitan SA. Its 2003 population of 2,728 ranked 51st in the state.

PER CAPITA PERSONAL INCOME

In 2003 Stanley had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$35,044. This PCPI ranked 5th in the state and was 120 percent of the state average, \$29,191, and 111 percent of the national average, \$31,504. The 2003 PCPI reflected an increase of 27.2 percent from 2002. The 2002-2003 state change was 8.0 percent and the national change was 2.2 percent. In 1993 the PCPI of Stanley was \$18,418 and ranked 18th in the state. The 1993-2003 average annual growth rate of PCPI was 6.6 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 4.8 percent and for the nation was 4.0 percent.

TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME

In 2003 Stanley had a total personal income (TPI) of \$95,600*. This TPI ranked 44th in the state and accounted for 0.4 percent of the state total. In 1993 the TPI of Stanley was \$46,229* and ranked 57th in the state. The 2003 TPI reflected an increase of 28.4 percent from 2002. The 2002-2003 state change was 8.7 percent and the national change was 3.1 percent. The 1993-2003 average annual growth rate of TPI was 7.5 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 5.4 percent and for the nation was 5.1 percent.

COMPONENTS OF TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME

Total personal income includes net earnings by place of residence; dividends, interest, and rent; and personal current transfer receipts received by the residents of Stanley. In 2003 net earnings accounted for 61.2 percent of TPI (compared with 66.8 in 1993); dividends, interest, and rent were 29.6 percent (compared with 22.6 in 1993); and personal current transfer receipts were 9.1 percent (compared with 10.6 in 1993). From 2002 to 2003 net earnings increased 41.7 percent; dividends, interest, and rent increased 13.1 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased 7.8 percent. From 1993 to 2003 net earnings increased on average 6.6 percent each year; dividends, interest, and rent increased on average 10.5 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased on average 5.9 percent.

EARNINGS BY PLACE OF WORK

Earnings of persons employed in Stanley increased from \$27,282* in 2002 to \$44,089* in 2003, an increase of 61.6 percent. The 2002-2003 state change was 11.1 percent and the national change was 3.8 percent. The average annual growth rate from the 1993 estimate of \$30,281* to the 2003 estimate was 3.8 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 5.3 percent and for the nation was 5.3 percent.
