



## **BEARFACTS 1993 – 2003**

### **Gaines , Texas [48165]**

Gaines is one of 254 counties in Texas. It is not part of a Metropolitan Area. Its 2003 population of 14,183 ranked 142nd in the state.

#### **PER CAPITA PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2003 Gaines had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$24,030. This PCPI ranked 108th in the state and was 82 percent of the state average, \$29,404, and 76 percent of the national average, \$31,504. The 2003 PCPI reflected an increase of 9.8 percent from 2002. The 2002-2003 state change was 2.0 percent and the national change was 2.2 percent. In 1993 the PCPI of Gaines was \$18,062 and ranked 70th in the state. The 1993-2003 average annual growth rate of PCPI was 2.9 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 4.2 percent and for the nation was 4.0 percent.

#### **TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2003 Gaines had a total personal income (TPI) of \$340,811\*. This TPI ranked 135th in the state and accounted for 0.1 percent of the state total. In 1993 the TPI of Gaines was \$254,295\* and ranked 126th in the state. The 2003 TPI reflected an increase of 10.7 percent from 2002. The 2002-2003 state change was 3.6 percent and the national change was 3.1 percent. The 1993-2003 average annual growth rate of TPI was 3.0 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 6.2 percent and for the nation was 5.1 percent.

#### **COMPONENTS OF TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

Total personal income includes net earnings by place of residence; dividends, interest, and rent; and personal current transfer receipts received by the residents of Gaines. In 2003 net earnings accounted for 72.8 percent of TPI (compared with 76.8 in 1993); dividends, interest, and rent were 9.8 percent (compared with 11.1 in 1993); and personal current transfer receipts were 17.4 percent (compared with 12.1 in 1993). From 2002 to 2003 net earnings increased 14.8 percent; dividends, interest, and rent decreased 5.6 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased 5.0 percent. From 1993 to 2003 net earnings increased on average 2.4 percent each year; dividends, interest, and rent increased on average 1.7 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased on average 6.8 percent.

#### **EARNINGS BY PLACE OF WORK**

Earnings of persons employed in Gaines increased from \$232,306\* in 2002 to \$262,048\* in 2003, an increase of 12.8 percent. The 2002-2003 state change was 3.5 percent and the national change was 3.8 percent. The average annual growth rate from the 1993 estimate of \$202,337\* to the 2003 estimate was 2.6 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 6.5 percent and for the nation was 5.3 percent.
