



BEARFACTS 1993 – 2003

Reeves , Texas [48389]

Reeves is one of 254 counties in Texas. It is part of the Pecos, TX Micropolitan SA. Its 2003 population of 12,026 ranked 155th in the state.

PER CAPITA PERSONAL INCOME

In 2003 Reeves had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$16,610. This PCPI ranked 241st in the state and was 56 percent of the state average, \$29,404, and 53 percent of the national average, \$31,504. The 2003 PCPI reflected an increase of 1.5 percent from 2002. The 2002-2003 state change was 2.0 percent and the national change was 2.2 percent. In 1993 the PCPI of Reeves was \$12,160 and ranked 235th in the state. The 1993-2003 average annual growth rate of PCPI was 3.2 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 4.2 percent and for the nation was 4.0 percent.

TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME

In 2003 Reeves had a total personal income (TPI) of \$199,753*. This TPI ranked 171st in the state and accounted for 0.0 percent of the state total. In 1993 the TPI of Reeves was \$185,085* and ranked 152nd in the state. The 2003 TPI reflected a decrease of 1.7 percent from 2002. The 2002-2003 state change was 3.6 percent and the national change was 3.1 percent. The 1993-2003 average annual growth rate of TPI was 0.8 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 6.2 percent and for the nation was 5.1 percent.

COMPONENTS OF TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME

Total personal income includes net earnings by place of residence; dividends, interest, and rent; and personal current transfer receipts received by the residents of Reeves. In 2003 net earnings accounted for 57.0 percent of TPI (compared with 66.8 in 1993); dividends, interest, and rent were 11.9 percent (compared with 12.3 in 1993); and personal current transfer receipts were 31.1 percent (compared with 20.9 in 1993). From 2002 to 2003 net earnings decreased 3.7 percent; dividends, interest, and rent increased 0.7 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased 1.4 percent. From 1993 to 2003 net earnings decreased on average 0.8 percent each year; dividends, interest, and rent increased on average 0.4 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased on average 4.8 percent.

EARNINGS BY PLACE OF WORK

Earnings of persons employed in Reeves decreased from \$133,604* in 2002 to \$126,865* in 2003, a decrease of 5.0 percent. The 2002-2003 state change was 3.5 percent and the national change was 3.8 percent. The average annual growth rate from the 1993 estimate of \$124,732* to the 2003 estimate was 0.2 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 6.5 percent and for the nation was 5.3 percent.
