



## **BEARFACTS 1993 – 2003**

### **Upton , Texas [48461]**

Upton is one of 254 counties in Texas. It is not part of a Metropolitan Area. Its 2003 population of 3,145 ranked 224th in the state.

#### **PER CAPITA PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2003 Upton had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$22,628. This PCPI ranked 149th in the state and was 77 percent of the state average, \$29,404, and 72 percent of the national average, \$31,504. The 2003 PCPI reflected an increase of 13.3 percent from 2002. The 2002-2003 state change was 2.0 percent and the national change was 2.2 percent. In 1993 the PCPI of Upton was \$17,333 and ranked 86th in the state. The 1993-2003 average annual growth rate of PCPI was 2.7 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 4.2 percent and for the nation was 4.0 percent.

#### **TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2003 Upton had a total personal income (TPI) of \$71,165\*. This TPI ranked 224th in the state and accounted for 0.0 percent of the state total. In 1993 the TPI of Upton was \$68,621\* and ranked 212th in the state. The 2003 TPI reflected an increase of 10.1 percent from 2002. The 2002-2003 state change was 3.6 percent and the national change was 3.1 percent. The 1993-2003 average annual growth rate of TPI was 0.4 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 6.2 percent and for the nation was 5.1 percent.

#### **COMPONENTS OF TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

Total personal income includes net earnings by place of residence; dividends, interest, and rent; and personal current transfer receipts received by the residents of Upton. In 2003 net earnings accounted for 61.9 percent of TPI (compared with 66.0 in 1993); dividends, interest, and rent were 16.0 percent (compared with 19.6 in 1993); and personal current transfer receipts were 22.2 percent (compared with 14.4 in 1993). From 2002 to 2003 net earnings increased 15.5 percent; dividends, interest, and rent decreased 0.7 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased 4.5 percent. From 1993 to 2003 net earnings decreased on average 0.3 percent each year; dividends, interest, and rent decreased on average 1.7 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased on average 4.8 percent.

#### **EARNINGS BY PLACE OF WORK**

Earnings of persons employed in Upton increased from \$41,573\* in 2002 to \$45,650\* in 2003, an increase of 9.8 percent. The 2002-2003 state change was 3.5 percent and the national change was 3.8 percent. The average annual growth rate from the 1993 estimate of \$52,691\* to the 2003 estimate was - 1.4 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 6.5 percent and for the nation was 5.3 percent.

*\*Note: All income estimates with the exception of PCPI are in thousands of dollars, not adjusted for inflation.*
