



BEARFACTS 1994 – 2004

Yakutat City and Borough , Alaska [02282]

Yakutat City and Borough is one of 27 counties in Alaska. It is not part of a Metropolitan Area. Its 2004 population of 711 ranked 27th in the state.

PER CAPITA PERSONAL INCOME

In 2004 Yakutat City and Borough had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$32,726. This PCPI ranked 9th in the state and was 96 percent of the state average, \$33,941, and 99 percent of the national average, \$33,157. The 2004 PCPI reflected an increase of 7.5 percent from 2003. The 2003-2004 state change was 4.2 percent and the national change was 5.2 percent. In 1994 the PCPI of Yakutat City and Borough was \$24,304 and ranked 10th in the state. The 1994-2004 average annual growth rate of PCPI was 3.0 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 3.1 percent and for the nation was 4.1 percent.

TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME

In 2004 Yakutat City and Borough had a total personal income (TPI) of \$23,268*. This TPI ranked 27th in the state and accounted for 0.1 percent of the state total. In 1994 the TPI of Yakutat City and Borough was \$19,565* and ranked 27th in the state. The 2004 TPI reflected an increase of 4.9 percent from 2003. The 2003-2004 state change was 5.9 percent and the national change was 6.1 percent. The 1994-2004 average annual growth rate of TPI was 1.7 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 4.0 percent and for the nation was 5.2 percent.

COMPONENTS OF TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME

Total personal income includes net earnings by place of residence; dividends, interest, and rent; and personal current transfer receipts received by the residents of Yakutat City and Borough. In 2004 net earnings accounted for 63.8 percent of TPI (compared with 65.5 in 1994); dividends, interest, and rent were 15.4 percent (compared with 20.1 in 1994); and personal current transfer receipts were 20.8 percent (compared with 14.4 in 1994). From 2003 to 2004 net earnings increased 9.4 percent; dividends, interest, and rent decreased 1.5 percent; and personal current transfer receipts decreased 2.9 percent. From 1994 to 2004 net earnings increased on average 1.5 percent each year; dividends, interest, and rent decreased on average 0.9 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased on average 5.6 percent.

EARNINGS BY PLACE OF WORK

Earnings of persons employed in Yakutat City and Borough increased from \$14,485* in 2003 to \$15,971* in 2004, an increase of 10.3 percent. The 2003-2004 state change was 7.6 percent and the national change was 6.5 percent. The average annual growth rate from the 1994 estimate of \$15,374* to the 2004 estimate was 0.4 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 4.0 percent and for the nation was 5.5 percent.
