



## **BEARFACTS 1994 – 2004**

### **Yukon-Koyukuk Census Area , Alaska [02290]**

Yukon-Koyukuk Census Area is one of 27 counties in Alaska. It is not part of a Metropolitan Area. Its 2004 population of 6,280 ranked 15th in the state.

#### **PER CAPITA PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2004 Yukon-Koyukuk Census Area had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$24,803. This PCPI ranked 24th in the state and was 73 percent of the state average, \$33,941, and 75 percent of the national average, \$33,157. The 2004 PCPI reflected an increase of 1.3 percent from 2003. The 2003-2004 state change was 4.2 percent and the national change was 5.2 percent. In 1994 the PCPI of Yukon-Koyukuk Census Area was \$15,452 and ranked 26th in the state. The 1994-2004 average annual growth rate of PCPI was 4.8 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 3.1 percent and for the nation was 4.1 percent.

#### **TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2004 Yukon-Koyukuk Census Area had a total personal income (TPI) of \$155,762\*. This TPI ranked 16th in the state and accounted for 0.7 percent of the state total. In 1994 the TPI of Yukon-Koyukuk Census Area was \$102,691\* and ranked 18th in the state. The 2004 TPI reflected an increase of 0.8 percent from 2003. The 2003-2004 state change was 5.9 percent and the national change was 6.1 percent. The 1994-2004 average annual growth rate of TPI was 4.3 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 4.0 percent and for the nation was 5.2 percent.

#### **COMPONENTS OF TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

Total personal income includes net earnings by place of residence; dividends, interest, and rent; and personal current transfer receipts received by the residents of Yukon-Koyukuk Census Area. In 2004 net earnings accounted for 53.4 percent of TPI (compared with 52.6 in 1994); dividends, interest, and rent were 13.6 percent (compared with 14.7 in 1994); and personal current transfer receipts were 33.0 percent (compared with 32.7 in 1994). From 2003 to 2004 net earnings increased 0.2 percent; dividends, interest, and rent increased 16.8 percent; and personal current transfer receipts decreased 3.6 percent. From 1994 to 2004 net earnings increased on average 4.4 percent each year; dividends, interest, and rent increased on average 3.4 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased on average 4.4 percent.

#### **EARNINGS BY PLACE OF WORK**

Earnings of persons employed in Yukon-Koyukuk Census Area decreased from \$117,241\* in 2003 to \$116,345\* in 2004, a decrease of 0.8 percent. The 2003-2004 state change was 7.6 percent and the national change was 6.5 percent. The average annual growth rate from the 1994 estimate of \$78,999\* to the 2004 estimate was 3.9 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 4.0 percent and for the nation was 5.5 percent.
