



## **BEARFACTS 1994 – 2004**

### **Meade , Kansas [20119]**

Meade is one of 105 counties in Kansas. It is not part of a Metropolitan Area. Its 2004 population of 4,506 ranked 72nd in the state.

#### **PER CAPITA PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2004 Meade had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$25,472. This PCPI ranked 46th in the state and was 82 percent of the state average, \$30,995, and 77 percent of the national average, \$33,123. The 2004 PCPI reflected a decrease of 0.5 percent from 2003. The 2003-2004 state change was 4.0 percent and the national change was 5.1 percent. In 1994 the PCPI of Meade was \$20,879 and ranked 20th in the state. The 1994-2004 average annual growth rate of PCPI was 2.0 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 4.0 percent and for the nation was 4.1 percent.

#### **TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2004 Meade had a total personal income (TPI) of \$114,775\*. This TPI ranked 73rd in the state and accounted for 0.1 percent of the state total. In 1994 the TPI of Meade was \$91,640\* and ranked 77th in the state. The 2004 TPI reflected a decrease of 1.5 percent from 2003. The 2003-2004 state change was 4.3 percent and the national change was 6.1 percent. The 1994-2004 average annual growth rate of TPI was 2.3 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 4.6 percent and for the nation was 5.2 percent.

#### **COMPONENTS OF TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

Total personal income includes net earnings by place of residence; dividends, interest, and rent; and personal current transfer receipts received by the residents of Meade. In 2004 net earnings accounted for 64.0 percent of TPI (compared with 64.4 in 1994); dividends, interest, and rent were 17.8 percent (compared with 20.4 in 1994); and personal current transfer receipts were 18.3 percent (compared with 15.3 in 1994). From 2003 to 2004 net earnings increased 1.0 percent; dividends, interest, and rent decreased 9.4 percent; and personal current transfer receipts decreased 1.4 percent. From 1994 to 2004 net earnings increased on average 2.2 percent each year; dividends, interest, and rent increased on average 0.9 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased on average 4.1 percent.

#### **EARNINGS BY PLACE OF WORK**

Earnings of persons employed in Meade increased from \$66,928\* in 2003 to \$67,800\* in 2004, an increase of 1.3 percent. The 2003-2004 state change was 5.7 percent and the national change was 6.5 percent. The average annual growth rate from the 1994 estimate of \$56,240\* to the 2004 estimate was 1.9 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 5.0 percent and for the nation was 5.5 percent.
