



## **BEARFACTS 1994 – 2004**

### **Mountrail , North Dakota [38061]**

Mountrail is one of 53 counties in North Dakota. It is not part of a Metropolitan Area. Its 2004 population of 6,505 ranked 20th in the state.

#### **PER CAPITA PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2004 Mountrail had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$28,577. This PCPI ranked 12th in the state and was 98 percent of the state average, \$29,307, and 86 percent of the national average, \$33,157. The 2004 PCPI reflected an increase of 9.0 percent from 2003. The 2003-2004 state change was 2.0 percent and the national change was 5.2 percent. In 1994 the PCPI of Mountrail was \$18,358 and ranked 26th in the state. The 1994-2004 average annual growth rate of PCPI was 4.5 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 4.4 percent and for the nation was 4.1 percent.

#### **TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2004 Mountrail had a total personal income (TPI) of \$185,895\*. This TPI ranked 19th in the state and accounted for 1.0 percent of the state total. In 1994 the TPI of Mountrail was \$126,265\* and ranked 19th in the state. The 2004 TPI reflected an increase of 9.8 percent from 2003. The 2003-2004 state change was 2.6 percent and the national change was 6.1 percent. The 1994-2004 average annual growth rate of TPI was 3.9 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 4.3 percent and for the nation was 5.2 percent.

#### **COMPONENTS OF TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

Total personal income includes net earnings by place of residence; dividends, interest, and rent; and personal current transfer receipts received by the residents of Mountrail. In 2004 net earnings accounted for 63.7 percent of TPI (compared with 60.5 in 1994); dividends, interest, and rent were 15.6 percent (compared with 18.6 in 1994); and personal current transfer receipts were 20.7 percent (compared with 20.9 in 1994). From 2003 to 2004 net earnings increased 14.8 percent; dividends, interest, and rent increased 0.8 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased 3.1 percent. From 1994 to 2004 net earnings increased on average 4.5 percent each year; dividends, interest, and rent increased on average 2.1 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased on average 3.8 percent.

#### **EARNINGS BY PLACE OF WORK**

Earnings of persons employed in Mountrail increased from \$101,593\* in 2003 to \$116,852\* in 2004, an increase of 15.0 percent. The 2003-2004 state change was 2.9 percent and the national change was 6.5 percent. The average annual growth rate from the 1994 estimate of \$79,715\* to the 2004 estimate was 3.9 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 4.6 percent and for the nation was 5.5 percent.
