



## **BEARFACTS 1994 – 2004**

### **San Patricio , Texas [48409]**

San Patricio is one of 254 counties in Texas. It is part of the [Corpus Christi, TX \(MSA\)](#). Its 2004 population of 67,694 ranked 48th in the state.

#### **PER CAPITA PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2004 San Patricio had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$23,651. This PCPI ranked 143rd in the state and was 76 percent of the state average, \$30,948, and 71 percent of the national average, \$33,123. The 2004 PCPI reflected an increase of 4.0 percent from 2003. The 2003-2004 state change was 5.3 percent and the national change was 5.1 percent. In 1994 the PCPI of San Patricio was \$14,691 and ranked 202nd in the state. The 1994-2004 average annual growth rate of PCPI was 4.9 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 4.4 percent and for the nation was 4.1 percent.

#### **TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2004 San Patricio had a total personal income (TPI) of \$1,601,064\*. This TPI ranked 49th in the state and accounted for 0.2 percent of the state total. In 1994 the TPI of San Patricio was \$924,269\* and ranked 49th in the state. The 2004 TPI reflected an increase of 5.0 percent from 2003. The 2003-2004 state change was 7.0 percent and the national change was 6.1 percent. The 1994-2004 average annual growth rate of TPI was 5.6 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 6.4 percent and for the nation was 5.2 percent.

#### **COMPONENTS OF TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

Total personal income includes net earnings by place of residence; dividends, interest, and rent; and personal current transfer receipts received by the residents of San Patricio. In 2004 net earnings accounted for 68.3 percent of TPI (compared with 65.9 in 1994); dividends, interest, and rent were 11.1 percent (compared with 13.7 in 1994); and personal current transfer receipts were 20.7 percent (compared with 20.4 in 1994). From 2003 to 2004 net earnings increased 3.8 percent; dividends, interest, and rent increased 12.0 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased 5.3 percent. From 1994 to 2004 net earnings increased on average 6.0 percent each year; dividends, interest, and rent increased on average 3.4 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased on average 5.8 percent.

#### **EARNINGS BY PLACE OF WORK**

Earnings of persons employed in San Patricio decreased from \$948,773\* in 2003 to \$935,781\* in 2004, a decrease of 1.4 percent. The 2003-2004 state change was 7.9 percent and the national change was 6.5 percent. The average annual growth rate from the 1994 estimate of \$497,719\* to the 2004 estimate was 6.5 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 6.8 percent and for the nation was 5.5 percent.
