



BEARFACTS 1994 – 2004

Zavala , Texas [48507]

Zavala is one of 254 counties in Texas. It is not part of a Metropolitan Area. Its 2004 population of 11,459 ranked 158th in the state.

PER CAPITA PERSONAL INCOME

In 2004 Zavala had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$14,022. This PCPI ranked 252nd in the state and was 45 percent of the state average, \$30,948, and 42 percent of the national average, \$33,123. The 2004 PCPI reflected a decrease of 0.3 percent from 2003. The 2003-2004 state change was 5.3 percent and the national change was 5.1 percent. In 1994 the PCPI of Zavala was \$8,457 and ranked 253rd in the state. The 1994-2004 average annual growth rate of PCPI was 5.2 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 4.4 percent and for the nation was 4.1 percent.

TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME

In 2004 Zavala had a total personal income (TPI) of \$160,677*. This TPI ranked 189th in the state and accounted for 0.0 percent of the state total. In 1994 the TPI of Zavala was \$101,793* and ranked 193rd in the state. The 2004 TPI reflected a decrease of 0.4 percent from 2003. The 2003-2004 state change was 7.0 percent and the national change was 6.1 percent. The 1994-2004 average annual growth rate of TPI was 4.7 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 6.4 percent and for the nation was 5.2 percent.

COMPONENTS OF TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME

Total personal income includes net earnings by place of residence; dividends, interest, and rent; and personal current transfer receipts received by the residents of Zavala. In 2004 net earnings accounted for 52.3 percent of TPI (compared with 49.6 in 1994); dividends, interest, and rent were 8.1 percent (compared with 11.2 in 1994); and personal current transfer receipts were 39.6 percent (compared with 39.3 in 1994). From 2003 to 2004 net earnings decreased 4.0 percent; dividends, interest, and rent increased 4.3 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased 3.9 percent. From 1994 to 2004 net earnings increased on average 5.2 percent each year; dividends, interest, and rent increased on average 1.3 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased on average 4.8 percent.

EARNINGS BY PLACE OF WORK

Earnings of persons employed in Zavala decreased from \$103,779* in 2003 to \$99,399* in 2004, a decrease of 4.2 percent. The 2003-2004 state change was 7.9 percent and the national change was 6.5 percent. The average annual growth rate from the 1994 estimate of \$57,180* to the 2004 estimate was 5.7 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 6.8 percent and for the nation was 5.5 percent.
