



## **BEARFACTS 1995 – 2005**

### **Alpine , California [06003]**

Alpine is one of 58 counties in California. It is not part of a Metropolitan Area. Its 2005 population of 1,125 ranked 58th in the state.

#### **PER CAPITA PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2005 Alpine had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$33,482. This PCPI ranked 22nd in the state and was 89 percent of the state average, \$37,418, and 97 percent of the national average, \$34,690. The 2005 PCPI reflected an increase of 4.9 percent from 2004. The 2004-2005 state change was 5.3 percent and the national change was 4.6 percent. In 1995 the PCPI of Alpine was \$18,243 and ranked 38th in the state. The 1995-2005 average annual growth rate of PCPI was 6.3 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 4.5 percent and for the nation was 4.2 percent.

#### **TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2005 Alpine had a total personal income (TPI) of \$37,667\*. This TPI ranked 58th in the state and accounted for 0.0 percent of the state total. In 1995 the TPI of Alpine was \$22,731\* and ranked 58th in the state. The 2005 TPI reflected a decrease of 0.4 percent from 2004. The 2004-2005 state change was 6.1 percent and the national change was 5.6 percent. The 1995-2005 average annual growth rate of TPI was 5.2 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 5.8 percent and for the nation was 5.3 percent.

#### **COMPONENTS OF TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

Total personal income includes net earnings by place of residence; dividends, interest, and rent; and personal current transfer receipts received by the residents of Alpine. In 2005 net earnings accounted for 63.5 percent of TPI (compared with 61.5 in 1995); dividends, interest, and rent were 15.2 percent (compared with 18.6 in 1995); and personal current transfer receipts were 21.3 percent (compared with 19.9 in 1995). From 2004 to 2005 net earnings increased 4.6 percent; dividends, interest, and rent decreased 18.4 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased 1.3 percent. From 1995 to 2005 net earnings increased on average 5.5 percent each year; dividends, interest, and rent increased on average 3.1 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased on average 5.9 percent.

#### **EARNINGS BY PLACE OF WORK**

Earnings of persons employed in Alpine increased from \$33,314\* in 2004 to \$34,999\* in 2005, an increase of 5.1 percent. The 2004-2005 state change was 5.7 percent and the national change was 5.3 percent. The average annual growth rate from the 1995 estimate of \$20,107\* to the 2005 estimate was 5.7 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 6.2 percent and for the nation was 5.5 percent.
