



BEARFACTS 1995 – 2005

Flagler , Florida [12035]

Flagler is one of 67 counties in Florida. It is part of the [Palm Coast, FL \(MSA\)](#). Its 2005 population of 75,338 ranked 36th in the state.

PER CAPITA PERSONAL INCOME

In 2005 Flagler had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$28,393. This PCPI ranked 27th in the state and was 82 percent of the state average, \$34,709, and 82 percent of the national average, \$34,690. The 2005 PCPI reflected an increase of 6.5 percent from 2004. The 2004-2005 state change was 6.2 percent and the national change was 4.6 percent. In 1995 the PCPI of Flagler was \$19,771 and ranked 24th in the state. The 1995-2005 average annual growth rate of PCPI was 3.7 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 4.3 percent and for the nation was 4.2 percent.

TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME

In 2005 Flagler had a total personal income (TPI) of \$2,139,054*. This TPI ranked 37th in the state and accounted for 0.3 percent of the state total. In 1995 the TPI of Flagler was \$791,095* and ranked 39th in the state. The 2005 TPI reflected an increase of 17.7 percent from 2004. The 2004-2005 state change was 8.6 percent and the national change was 5.6 percent. The 1995-2005 average annual growth rate of TPI was 10.5 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 6.4 percent and for the nation was 5.3 percent.

COMPONENTS OF TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME

Total personal income includes net earnings by place of residence; dividends, interest, and rent; and personal current transfer receipts received by the residents of Flagler. In 2005 net earnings accounted for 44.7 percent of TPI (compared with 45.4 in 1995); dividends, interest, and rent were 33.3 percent (compared with 32.3 in 1995); and personal current transfer receipts were 21.9 percent (compared with 22.3 in 1995). From 2004 to 2005 net earnings increased 24.2 percent; dividends, interest, and rent increased 13.4 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased 12.3 percent. From 1995 to 2005 net earnings increased on average 10.3 percent each year; dividends, interest, and rent increased on average 10.8 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased on average 10.3 percent.

EARNINGS BY PLACE OF WORK

Earnings of persons employed in Flagler increased from \$631,363* in 2004 to \$722,733* in 2005, an increase of 14.5 percent. The 2004-2005 state change was 8.9 percent and the national change was 5.3 percent. The average annual growth rate from the 1995 estimate of \$258,652* to the 2005 estimate was 10.8 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 6.7 percent and for the nation was 5.5 percent.
