



## **BEARFACTS 1995 – 2005**

### **Montour , Pennsylvania [42093]**

Montour is one of 67 counties in Pennsylvania. It is part of the Bloomsburg-Berwick, PA Micropolitan SA. Its 2005 population of 17,924 ranked 62nd in the state.

#### **PER CAPITA PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2005 Montour had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$33,627. This PCPI ranked 10th in the state and was 96 percent of the state average, \$34,927, and 97 percent of the national average, \$34,757. The 2005 PCPI reflected an increase of 4.0 percent from 2004. The 2004-2005 state change was 4.2 percent and the national change was 4.9 percent. In 1995 the PCPI of Montour was \$21,033 and ranked 19th in the state. The 1995-2005 average annual growth rate of PCPI was 4.8 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 4.1 percent and for the nation was 4.2 percent.

#### **TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2005 Montour had a total personal income (TPI) of \$602,737\*. This TPI ranked 62nd in the state and accounted for 0.1 percent of the state total. In 1995 the TPI of Montour was \$388,916\* and ranked 61st in the state. The 2005 TPI reflected an increase of 3.7 percent from 2004. The 2004-2005 state change was 4.4 percent and the national change was 5.9 percent. The 1995-2005 average annual growth rate of TPI was 4.5 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 4.3 percent and for the nation was 5.3 percent.

#### **COMPONENTS OF TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

Total personal income includes net earnings by place of residence; dividends, interest, and rent; and personal current transfer receipts received by the residents of Montour. In 2005 net earnings accounted for 66.9 percent of TPI (compared with 65.1 in 1995); dividends, interest, and rent were 13.1 percent (compared with 14.4 in 1995); and personal current transfer receipts were 19.9 percent (compared with 20.5 in 1995). From 2004 to 2005 net earnings increased 5.0 percent; dividends, interest, and rent decreased 3.6 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased 4.9 percent. From 1995 to 2005 net earnings increased on average 4.8 percent each year; dividends, interest, and rent increased on average 3.5 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased on average 4.2 percent.

#### **EARNINGS BY PLACE OF WORK**

Earnings of persons employed in Montour increased from \$687,081\* in 2004 to \$736,544\* in 2005, an increase of 7.2 percent. The 2004-2005 state change was 4.5 percent and the national change was 5.4 percent. The average annual growth rate from the 1995 estimate of \$440,334\* to the 2005 estimate was 5.3 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 4.5 percent and for the nation was 5.5 percent.
