



## **BEARFACTS 1995 – 2005**

### **Clark , South Dakota [46025]**

Clark is one of 66 counties in South Dakota. It is not part of a Metropolitan Area. Its 2005 population of 3,673 ranked 43rd in the state.

#### **PER CAPITA PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2005 Clark had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$32,675. This PCPI ranked 21st in the state and was 101 percent of the state average, \$32,193, and 94 percent of the national average, \$34,690. The 2005 PCPI reflected an increase of 4.2 percent from 2004. The 2004-2005 state change was 4.4 percent and the national change was 4.6 percent. In 1995 the PCPI of Clark was \$18,348 and ranked 23rd in the state. The 1995-2005 average annual growth rate of PCPI was 5.9 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 5.1 percent and for the nation was 4.2 percent.

#### **TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2005 Clark had a total personal income (TPI) of \$120,017\*. This TPI ranked 42nd in the state and accounted for 0.5 percent of the state total. In 1995 the TPI of Clark was \$79,247\* and ranked 39th in the state. The 2005 TPI reflected an increase of 1.4 percent from 2004. The 2004-2005 state change was 5.2 percent and the national change was 5.6 percent. The 1995-2005 average annual growth rate of TPI was 4.2 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 5.7 percent and for the nation was 5.3 percent.

#### **COMPONENTS OF TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

Total personal income includes net earnings by place of residence; dividends, interest, and rent; and personal current transfer receipts received by the residents of Clark. In 2005 net earnings accounted for 69.7 percent of TPI (compared with 59.7 in 1995); dividends, interest, and rent were 14.4 percent (compared with 22.2 in 1995); and personal current transfer receipts were 15.9 percent (compared with 18.0 in 1995). From 2004 to 2005 net earnings increased 5.2 percent; dividends, interest, and rent decreased 15.6 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased 3.6 percent. From 1995 to 2005 net earnings increased on average 5.9 percent each year; dividends, interest, and rent decreased on average 0.2 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased on average 2.9 percent.

#### **EARNINGS BY PLACE OF WORK**

Earnings of persons employed in Clark increased from \$76,461\* in 2004 to \$80,368\* in 2005, an increase of 5.1 percent. The 2004-2005 state change was 4.4 percent and the national change was 5.3 percent. The average annual growth rate from the 1995 estimate of \$46,737\* to the 2005 estimate was 5.6 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 5.7 percent and for the nation was 5.5 percent.
