



## **BEARFACTS 1995 – 2005**

### **Nacogdoches , Texas [48347]**

Nacogdoches is one of 254 counties in Texas. It is part of the Nacogdoches, TX Micropolitan SA. Its 2005 population of 61,269 ranked 53rd in the state.

#### **PER CAPITA PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2005 Nacogdoches had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$22,688. This PCPI ranked 194th in the state and was 68 percent of the state average, \$33,253, and 65 percent of the national average, \$34,757. The 2005 PCPI reflected an increase of 5.1 percent from 2004. The 2004-2005 state change was 7.4 percent and the national change was 4.9 percent. In 1995 the PCPI of Nacogdoches was \$15,951 and ranked 171st in the state. The 1995-2005 average annual growth rate of PCPI was 3.6 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 4.7 percent and for the nation was 4.2 percent.

#### **TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2005 Nacogdoches had a total personal income (TPI) of \$1,390,062\*. This TPI ranked 57th in the state and accounted for 0.2 percent of the state total. In 1995 the TPI of Nacogdoches was \$911,912\* and ranked 51st in the state. The 2005 TPI reflected an increase of 6.2 percent from 2004. The 2004-2005 state change was 9.3 percent and the national change was 5.9 percent. The 1995-2005 average annual growth rate of TPI was 4.3 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 6.7 percent and for the nation was 5.3 percent.

#### **COMPONENTS OF TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

Total personal income includes net earnings by place of residence; dividends, interest, and rent; and personal current transfer receipts received by the residents of Nacogdoches. In 2005 net earnings accounted for 60.2 percent of TPI (compared with 61.0 in 1995); dividends, interest, and rent were 17.2 percent (compared with 19.2 in 1995); and personal current transfer receipts were 22.6 percent (compared with 19.8 in 1995). From 2004 to 2005 net earnings increased 4.3 percent; dividends, interest, and rent increased 7.9 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased 9.9 percent. From 1995 to 2005 net earnings increased on average 4.2 percent each year; dividends, interest, and rent increased on average 3.2 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased on average 5.7 percent.

#### **EARNINGS BY PLACE OF WORK**

Earnings of persons employed in Nacogdoches increased from \$868,598\* in 2004 to \$906,794\* in 2005, an increase of 4.4 percent. The 2004-2005 state change was 7.6 percent and the national change was 5.4 percent. The average annual growth rate from the 1995 estimate of \$597,139\* to the 2005 estimate was 4.3 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 6.9 percent and for the nation was 5.5 percent.

*\*Note: All income estimates with the exception of PCPI are in thousands of dollars, not adjusted for inflation.*
