



BEARFACTS 1995 – 2005

Rockwall , Texas [48397]

Rockwall is one of 254 counties in Texas. It is part of the [Dallas-Fort Worth-Arlington, TX \(MSA\)](#). Its 2005 population of 62,069 ranked 52nd in the state.

PER CAPITA PERSONAL INCOME

In 2005 Rockwall had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$37,837. This PCPI ranked 13th in the state and was 114 percent of the state average, \$33,253, and 109 percent of the national average, \$34,757. The 2005 PCPI reflected an increase of 6.4 percent from 2004. The 2004-2005 state change was 7.4 percent and the national change was 4.9 percent. In 1995 the PCPI of Rockwall was \$27,943 and ranked 5th in the state. The 1995-2005 average annual growth rate of PCPI was 3.1 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 4.7 percent and for the nation was 4.2 percent.

TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME

In 2005 Rockwall had a total personal income (TPI) of \$2,348,483*. This TPI ranked 43rd in the state and accounted for 0.3 percent of the state total. In 1995 the TPI of Rockwall was \$934,091* and ranked 50th in the state. The 2005 TPI reflected an increase of 14.3 percent from 2004. The 2004-2005 state change was 9.3 percent and the national change was 5.9 percent. The 1995-2005 average annual growth rate of TPI was 9.7 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 6.7 percent and for the nation was 5.3 percent.

COMPONENTS OF TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME

Total personal income includes net earnings by place of residence; dividends, interest, and rent; and personal current transfer receipts received by the residents of Rockwall. In 2005 net earnings accounted for 77.4 percent of TPI (compared with 79.4 in 1995); dividends, interest, and rent were 14.8 percent (compared with 13.6 in 1995); and personal current transfer receipts were 7.8 percent (compared with 6.9 in 1995). From 2004 to 2005 net earnings increased 11.5 percent; dividends, interest, and rent increased 31.4 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased 14.4 percent. From 1995 to 2005 net earnings increased on average 9.4 percent each year; dividends, interest, and rent increased on average 10.5 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased on average 10.9 percent.

EARNINGS BY PLACE OF WORK

Earnings of persons employed in Rockwall increased from \$756,382* in 2004 to \$824,720* in 2005, an increase of 9.0 percent. The 2004-2005 state change was 7.6 percent and the national change was 5.4 percent. The average annual growth rate from the 1995 estimate of \$298,976* to the 2005 estimate was 10.7 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 6.9 percent and for the nation was 5.5 percent.
