



BEARFACTS 1995 – 2005

Pendleton-Hermiston (BEA-EA) [57124]

Pendleton-Hermiston is one of 179 BEA Economic Areas in the nation. Its 2005 population of 141,956 ranked 173rd in the nation.

PER CAPITA PERSONAL INCOME

In 2005 Pendleton-Hermiston had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$24,627. This PCPI ranked 171st in the United States and was 71 percent of the national average, \$34,757. The 2005 PCPI reflected a decrease of 1.0 percent from 2004. The 2004-2005 national change was 4.9 percent. In 1995 the PCPI of Pendleton-Hermiston was \$17,750 and ranked 151st in the United States. The 1995-2005 average annual growth rate of PCPI was 3.3 percent. The average annual growth rate for the nation was 4.2 percent.

TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME

In 2005 Pendleton-Hermiston had a total personal income (TPI) of \$3,495,922*. This TPI ranked 176th in the United States. In 1995 the TPI of Pendleton-Hermiston was \$2,398,776* and ranked 175th in the United States. The 2005 TPI reflected a decrease of 1.1 percent from 2004. The 2004-2005 national change was 5.9 percent. The 1995-2005 average annual growth rate of TPI was 3.8 percent. The average annual growth rate for the nation was 5.3 percent.

COMPONENTS OF TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME

Total personal income includes net earnings by place of residence; dividends, interest, and rent; and personal current transfer receipts received by the residents of Pendleton-Hermiston. In 2005 net earnings accounted for 60.9 percent of TPI (compared with 57.8 in 1995); dividends, interest, and rent were 17.6 percent (compared with 23.0 in 1995); and personal current transfer receipts were 21.5 percent (compared with 19.1 in 1995). From 2004 to 2005 net earnings decreased 1.8 percent; dividends, interest, and rent decreased 6.0 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased 5.6 percent. From 1995 to 2005 net earnings increased on average 4.4 percent each year; dividends, interest, and rent increased on average 1.1 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased on average 5.0 percent.

EARNINGS BY PLACE OF WORK

Earnings of persons employed in Pendleton-Hermiston decreased from \$2,469,929* in 2004 to \$2,428,978* in 2005, a decrease of 1.7 percent. The 2004-2005 national change was 5.4 percent. The average annual growth rate from the 1995 estimate of \$1,569,809* to the 2005 estimate was 4.5 percent. The average annual growth rate for the nation was 5.5 percent.
