



BEARFACTS 1996 – 2006

Yakutat City and Borough , Alaska [02282]

Yakutat City and Borough is one of 27 counties in Alaska. It is not part of a Metropolitan Area. Its 2006 population of 665 ranked 27th in the state.

PER CAPITA PERSONAL INCOME

In 2006 Yakutat City and Borough had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$39,328. This PCPI ranked 8th in the state and was 103 percent of the state average, \$38,344, and 107 percent of the national average, \$36,794. The 2006 PCPI reflected an increase of 10.7 percent from 2005. The 2005-2006 state change was 6.3 percent and the national change was 6.1 percent. In 1996 the PCPI of Yakutat City and Borough was \$22,957 and ranked 14th in the state. The 1996-2006 average annual growth rate of PCPI was 5.5 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 4.0 percent and for the nation was 4.3 percent.

TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME

In 2006 Yakutat City and Borough had a total personal income (TPI) of \$26,153*. This TPI ranked 27th in the state and accounted for 0.1 percent of the state total. In 1996 the TPI of Yakutat City and Borough was \$21,396* and ranked 27th in the state. The 2006 TPI reflected an increase of 8.6 percent from 2005. The 2005-2006 state change was 7.5 percent and the national change was 7.1 percent. The 1996-2006 average annual growth rate of TPI was 2.0 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 5.1 percent and for the nation was 5.4 percent.

COMPONENTS OF TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME

Total personal income includes net earnings by place of residence; dividends, interest, and rent; and personal current transfer receipts received by the residents of Yakutat City and Borough. In 2006 net earnings accounted for 65.5 percent of TPI (compared with 64.2 in 1996); dividends, interest, and rent were 13.1 percent (compared with 20.7 in 1996); and personal current transfer receipts were 21.4 percent (compared with 15.1 in 1996). From 2005 to 2006 net earnings increased 14.4 percent; dividends, interest, and rent decreased 4.8 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased 1.8 percent. From 1996 to 2006 net earnings increased on average 2.2 percent each year; dividends, interest, and rent decreased on average 2.5 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased on average 5.7 percent.

EARNINGS BY PLACE OF WORK

Earnings of persons employed in Yakutat City and Borough increased from \$16,074* in 2005 to \$18,550* in 2006, an increase of 15.4 percent. The 2005-2006 state change was 6.6 percent and the national change was 5.8 percent. The average annual growth rate from the 1996 estimate of \$19,104* to the 2006 estimate was - 0.3 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 5.2 percent and for the nation was 5.5 percent.
