



## **BEARFACTS 1996 – 2006**

### **Coahoma , Mississippi [28027]**

Coahoma is one of 82 counties in Mississippi. It is part of the Clarksdale, MS Micropolitan SA. Its 2006 population of 27,971 ranked 34th in the state.

#### **PER CAPITA PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2006 Coahoma had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$25,186. This PCPI ranked 23rd in the state and was 93 percent of the state average, \$27,072, and 68 percent of the national average, \$36,794. The 2006 PCPI reflected an increase of 2.5 percent from 2005. The 2005-2006 state change was 7.1 percent and the national change was 6.1 percent. In 1996 the PCPI of Coahoma was \$16,940 and ranked 22nd in the state. The 1996-2006 average annual growth rate of PCPI was 4.0 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 4.3 percent and for the nation was 4.3 percent.

#### **TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2006 Coahoma had a total personal income (TPI) of \$704,468\*. This TPI ranked 29th in the state and accounted for 0.9 percent of the state total. In 1996 the TPI of Coahoma was \$532,465\* and ranked 25th in the state. The 2006 TPI reflected an increase of 1.5 percent from 2005. The 2005-2006 state change was 7.0 percent and the national change was 7.1 percent. The 1996-2006 average annual growth rate of TPI was 2.8 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 4.9 percent and for the nation was 5.4 percent.

#### **COMPONENTS OF TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

Total personal income includes net earnings by place of residence; dividends, interest, and rent; and personal current transfer receipts received by the residents of Coahoma. In 2006 net earnings accounted for 51.2 percent of TPI (compared with 56.8 in 1996); dividends, interest, and rent were 16.9 percent (compared with 15.5 in 1996); and personal current transfer receipts were 31.9 percent (compared with 27.6 in 1996). From 2005 to 2006 net earnings decreased 5.5 percent; dividends, interest, and rent increased 23.1 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased 4.2 percent. From 1996 to 2006 net earnings increased on average 1.8 percent each year; dividends, interest, and rent increased on average 3.7 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased on average 4.3 percent.

#### **EARNINGS BY PLACE OF WORK**

Earnings of persons employed in Coahoma decreased from \$415,208\* in 2005 to \$389,283\* in 2006, a decrease of 6.2 percent. The 2005-2006 state change was 4.7 percent and the national change was 5.8 percent. The average annual growth rate from the 1996 estimate of \$346,312\* to the 2006 estimate was 1.2 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 4.5 percent and for the nation was 5.5 percent.
