



## **BEARFACTS 1996 – 2006**

### **Hayes , Nebraska [31085]**

Hayes is one of 93 counties in Nebraska. It is not part of a Metropolitan Area. Its 2006 population of 992 ranked 82nd in the state.

#### **PER CAPITA PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2006 Hayes had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$20,491. This PCPI ranked 86th in the state and was 59 percent of the state average, \$34,440, and 56 percent of the national average, \$36,714. The 2006 PCPI reflected a decrease of 5.3 percent from 2005. The 2005-2006 state change was 4.7 percent and the national change was 5.6 percent. In 1996 the PCPI of Hayes was \$22,004 and ranked 29th in the state. The 1996-2006 average annual growth rate of PCPI was - 0.7 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 3.9 percent and for the nation was 4.3 percent.

#### **TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2006 Hayes had a total personal income (TPI) of \$20,327\*. This TPI ranked 83rd in the state and accounted for 0.0 percent of the state total. In 1996 the TPI of Hayes was \$24,336\* and ranked 82nd in the state. The 2006 TPI reflected a decrease of 9.9 percent from 2005. The 2005-2006 state change was 5.3 percent and the national change was 6.7 percent. The 1996-2006 average annual growth rate of TPI was - 1.8 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 4.4 percent and for the nation was 5.4 percent.

#### **COMPONENTS OF TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

Total personal income includes net earnings by place of residence; dividends, interest, and rent; and personal current transfer receipts received by the residents of Hayes. In 2006 net earnings accounted for 63.2 percent of TPI (compared with 69.7 in 1996); dividends, interest, and rent were 14.8 percent (compared with 18.1 in 1996); and personal current transfer receipts were 21.9 percent (compared with 12.2 in 1996). From 2005 to 2006 net earnings decreased 16.3 percent; dividends, interest, and rent increased 1.3 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased 5.6 percent. From 1996 to 2006 net earnings decreased on average 2.7 percent each year; dividends, interest, and rent decreased on average 3.7 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased on average 4.1 percent.

#### **EARNINGS BY PLACE OF WORK**

Earnings of persons employed in Hayes decreased from \$14,508\* in 2005 to \$12,000\* in 2006, a decrease of 17.3 percent. The 2005-2006 state change was 3.9 percent and the national change was 5.7 percent. The average annual growth rate from the 1996 estimate of \$15,550\* to the 2006 estimate was - 2.6 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 4.4 percent and for the nation was 5.5 percent.

*\*Note: All income estimates with the exception of PCPI are in thousands of dollars, not adjusted for inflation.*
